### **PROJECTS**

### **AWAAHAN**

 A community service team created by the student volunteers of classes IX and X, dedicated to maintaining cleanliness, school infrastructure and systematic student dispersal. The motive is to make the children "own" the school.

#### CHAMPIONS FOR CHANGE

- The school has been nominated for the Cine/Art Steer to Safety program Champions for Change'led by PVR Nest and supported by Michelin India. The aim is to sensitize school students on road safety issues.
- **Vroom Club**, started by the students of classes VI to X, generated road safety awareness among the students by conducting workshops, screenings and demonstrations.





### LITERACY THROUGH READING PROJECT

 Online Readers Club was formed to connect all the libraries of various BBPS units. A team of students of classes IX and X undertook book discussions, debates and discussions on various issues every month, as part of the club activities.
