# **UPDATED POLICY FOR CLASSES VI TO X (2017-18)**

Class- VI to X Evaluation System (2017-18)

CBSE has restored the Board Examination with effect from the academic session 2017-18. The assessment for Scholastic and Co Scholastic domain will therefore be according to the CBSE guidelines for Classes VI to X.

## **Assessment Structure**

No Semester System: Final Examination will be held at the end of each academic session.

- Syllabus will be prescribed for the classes VI and VII by the teachers.
- VIII, IX and X shall have 100 % syllabus coverage for the End Term Examination.
- The End Term Examination for Class X will be conducted by CBSE whereas for other classes it will be conducted by the school under the guidelines given by CBSE.

## Scholastic Area

- (i) The Mid Term and the End Term exam will comprise of the marks of Paper Pen Test (80 Marks) and Internal Assessment (20 Marks).
- (ii) For promotion to the next class a student needs to secure 33% both in Paper Pen Test and Internal Assessment.

#### **Internal Assessment:**

- (i) Internal Assessment comprises of Periodic Test (10 marks), Notebook Submission (5 marks) and Subject Enrichment activity (5 Marks).
- (ii) Periodic Tests: The students will be assessed regularly through Periodic Test. For the final marks submission average converted out of 10 will be considered.
- (iii) Notebook assessment will be carried out at the end of every month on the basis of following parameters:
  - (a) Regularity
- (b) Assignment Completion
- (c) Neatness

- (d) Timely submission
- (e) correction work by the student.
- \* Average of the marks obtained at the end of each month shall be the final marks.

## **Subject Specific Application Activities:**

Languages (English and Hindi ): Speaking listening skills (IX & X) , Activities such as Spell Test and Just a Minute etc. (VI to VIII)

Mathematics and Science: Lab activities and Projects.

Social Science: Disaster Management projects or Project Work on popular struggles and movements on Money and Credit.

#### Co Scholastic Area

- (i) Co Scholastic activities will be assessed on a 5 point grading scale (A to E) by the concerned teacher framing the effective tools for the same.
- (ii) Grading will not have any descriptive indicator and the students will not be upgraded based on the Co Scholastic Grades.
- (iii) Co scholastic area will cover work Education, Visual and Performing Art, Physical and Heath Education

## Discipline:

Students will be graded by the class teacher for discipline on a five point grading scale (A to E) considering the attendance, sincerity, behaviour and values.

### Attendance

Every student must have a minimum of 75% attendance, failing which he/she will not be allowed to sit in the final examination/will not be promoted to the next higher class.

- (i) Please discourage the student from missing an exam unless on grounds of extreme emergency like a contagious disease, a fracture etc.
- (ii) Cycle Test / Final Report Cards will be given to the parents/students, both with marks and grades.

Policy for classes VI to X (Middle & Secondary)

Detention: Class-VI to VIII: As per DOE guidelines Class IX & X: As per CBSE guidelines

Missed Test / Exams: (VI to X)

a) Missed any Cycle Test / Activity

No Retest will be conducted.

The school reserves the right to take the decision of marking the student with

b) Missed the Mid Term : Retest as per the schedule drawn.

Retest shall be conducted only once

c) Missed the End Term (VI to IX only) : Retest as per the schedule drawn.

(alongwith compartment cases)
Retest shall be conducted only once

\* The student who misses any exam during the session will not be considered for any recognition such as Scholar Badge, Bench Mark and so on.

#### **PASS CRITERIA**

According to CBSE circular no. Acad-05/2017, dated 31/01/2017 / Acad 14-2017, dated 21/03/2017 (Grading)

"In the scholastic area, student has to secure minimum 33% marks out of 80 marks in each subject in the End Term and minimum 33% marks out of 20 marks in the Internal Assessment separately."

#### Retest / Compartment (Class-IX)

A student scoring less than 33% in one subject will be permitted **Retest** in that subject. A student scoring less than 33% in 2 subjects will be **detained**.

The student has to secure minimum 33% in the Retest exam and 33% in the aggregate (20% Internal Assessment, 20% Mid Term Exam and 60% Annual Exam) Annual Result for promotion to the next class.
