### Inter-School Astropoetry Competition (Do it from home) Contest Rules:

Astronomy Club organizes Astropoetry competition for students of classes III-XII in which they have to write poem on any topic related to Astronomy.

I) Poem must be in English and original.

- II) Poem may be on any astronomy theme, night sky, or space-related subject. Poems may be in any style or
- III) Number of lines should be less than 30.
- IV) Students should mention their full name, class, section and title of the poem.

## Inter-School Astroart Competition (Do it from home)

Astronomy Club organizes Astroart competition for students of classes III-XII in which they have to present art work on the theme Astronomy.

- i) Artwork must be a unique piece created by the entrant.
- ii) Entrants may provide a title and caption to their art.
- iii) Students should mention their full name, class, section and title of the Art.

Note: The submissions need to be done by April 18, 2018. Students of class III-V will submit it to their class teachers. Students of class VI-XII will submit it to Ms. Chitra in Physics lab.

Note: This competition is open for adults as well with the same guidelines mentioned above.
