SPACE invites entries for the annual World Space Week “*Inter-School Astrotoon Competition*” for students at primary, secondary and sr. secondary level. Schools should send softcopies of their creations as entries in the interschool competition.

Details

1. Categories

- a. Group I: Class II to III
- b. Group II: Class IV and V
- c. Group III: Class VI to VIII
- d. Group IV: Class IX to XII

2. Theme :EXPLORING THE NEW WORLD IN SPACE

Let your imagination soar the universe! Visualize another Earth like human colony in Space. This is an outward facing theme that serves to inspire the population through putting the spotlight on the potential and wonder of space for our future evolution. It highlights space missions exploring deep space like New Horizons; concrete space projects that facilitate the exploration of new worlds such as Lockheed’s Orion Crew Vehicle, and big goals such as the Space X mission to Mars.

1. All entries should be submitted online from 4thOctober 2017 to 15th October 2017.

2. Only 1 Cartoon Strip per student will be accepted.
3. For **Group I and II**, the Astrotoon should be plotted on an **A4 sheet**.
4. For **Group III and IV**, the Astrotoon should be plotted on an **A3 sheet**.
5. **Group I and II** students has to make a single panel cartoon. Multiple panels will not be accepted. All of their creativities should be done within that single panel only.
6. **Group III and IV** students can create multiple panels (Minimum 4 and maximum 6) within the sheet to present their storyline.
7. Student may add their signature at the bottom right corner of the sheet.
8. Cartoon Strip should be scanned with high resolution (200 dpi or better). As an alternate students can also use a good quality camera (preferably a DSLR) to capture a high resolution photograph of the Cartoon Strip.
9. Any coloring medium can be used, however no computer generated paintings will be accepted (e.g. Using software such as Illustrator)
10. All the entries submitted will become SPACE property. Further, it can be used anywhere by SPACE.
11. Cartoons will be judged on the basis of originality, technique, style, composition, context, creativity and imagination as well as relevance to theme.
