Reading makes a big difference to children's educational performance. Children who read for enjoyment every day not only perform better in academics but also develop a broader vocabulary, increased general knowledge and a better understanding of other cultures. Teachers create readers in the class by teaching students how to read, by being a reading role model and by creating a classroom culture where reading for pleasure is encouraged and supported.

Keeping this in mind, we have introduced a **Reading Period** 4 days a week in the Primary Dept. Story books have been chosen with great care and multiple copies bought of each. The teacher issues one set for her class and distributes one copy of the same on each table. She then begins by model reading along with the children. A lot of verbal interaction is part of this session. The next day the students continue reading the same story.

The whole purpose is to inspire in children a love for reading.

Parents play a critical role in helping their children develop not only the ability to read, but also an enjoyment of reading.

Turn off the screens. Start by limiting TV viewing time.

Teach by example. If you have books, newspapers and magazines around your house, and your child sees you reading, then your child will learn that you value reading.

Read together. Reading with your child is a great activity. It is a wonderful way to foster a language rich environment in your family. Books can really open the lines of communication between parents and children.

Let us work together to create lifelong readers.
