**CIRCULAR FOR PARENTS OF CLASS XII STUDENTS**

**Dear Parent,**

**07<sup>th</sup> May, 2019**

First of all, let me congratulate you and your ward for the great performance in class XII and wish each of our children a bright future ahead. Bal Bharati Public School, Pitampura, focuses on imparting value-based quality education with global dimensions along with an added element of experiential learning. We promote the holistic development of our students in which you, as a parent, have been playing a pivotal role, helping the school to achieve greater heights of success. The school, under the aegis of the Child Education Society, carries forth the legacy of more than 75 years of educational excellence and innovation and has been ranked as the no. 1 school of the region. You are aware that the school has not been permitted to hike the fee right from year 2016 onwards. On the other hand, expenses have been mounting up due to yearly increments on account of D.A. etc. and general inflation and especially in the wake of Implementation of 7<sup>th</sup> Pay Commission which is still in abeyance. The school has tried its utmost to reduce expenses and even gone to the extent of limiting the employer's PF contribution for employees with effect from session 2018-19.

The impact of salary hike on account of 7<sup>th</sup> Pay Commission is calculated between 25%-30% and with arrears w.e.f. January 1, 2016, the impact comes out to be even higher. The situation would never have been so critical if the government had allowed the schools to increase the fee at a reasonable rate (about 10% as in the past) from the year 2016-17 onwards.

Looking into the accumulated deficit of the school and also keeping in mind the burden on parents, the school had proposed a modest hike of 15% in Tuition Fee, Rs. 1000/- in Annual charges, Rs. 25/- per month in Activity Fees and Rs. 300/- per month in Transport Fees for the year 2018-19. With a view to service the mounting deficit of the last three years to sustain the smooth and efficient working, the school proposes to recover arrears for 2018-19. The total amount of arrears for 2018-19 for class XII is Rs. 16,420/ (Tuition Fee Arrear Rs. 1260/- per month x 12 = Rs. 15120/- + Activity Fee Rs. 25/- per month x 12 = Rs. 300/- + Annual Charge 1000/-). We request you to pay the arrears immediately. You may submit a Demand Draft/ Banker Cheque drawn in favour of Bal Bharati Public School, Pitampura in the school.

We hope you will appreciate the precarious financial position of the school and shall extend your full support, as always, to enable us to continue providing quality education, for which the school is known, to our children.
