

NOUNS



<u>Proper noun</u>- A proper noun denotes a particular name, place, animal or thing. Proper nouns are capitalized. **Examples** of proper nouns are John, Sakshi, Honda, Taj Mahal, Pepsi, English, October etc.





Proper noun examples in the following sentences are in bold for easy identification.

- a) Emily loved spending time with Nancy in Paris.
- b) Mars is called the red planet.
