
TOPIC – Kinds of Nouns

You have learnt about the first four Kinds of Nouns- Common, Proper, Collective and Abstract in Class IV. Let's revise the first three of them here......

LET'S REVISE

- Nouns refer to naming words, that is, they name a person, place, animal or thing.
- Common Nouns are the names of a person, place or thing in general, such as, a boy, a book, a city, a school, a river and so on. (Remember Common Nouns do not begin with a capital letter)
- ➤ **Proper Nouns** refer to specific names, that is, the name of a particular person, place, animal or thing, such as, Manish, Meeta, Jumbo, Yamuna, The Bible, London and so on. (Remember Proper Nouns always begin with a capital letter)
- Collective Nouns refer to groups of people, animals or things, such as, an audience, a family, a herd of cattle, a swarm of bees, a pile of books and so on
