You have revised about the first three Kinds of Nouns- Common, Proper and Collective in Part I of this sheet. Let's now learn about the next two Kinds of Nouns, that is, Abstract and Concrete Nouns.....

❖ ABSTRACT NOUNS

An abstract noun is a noun that refers to an emotion, a feeling, a quality, or an idea. In other words, an abstract noun does not refer to a physical object.

An abstract noun is a word that names something that you cannot see, hear, touch, smell, or taste (i.e., something you cannot perceive with one of your five senses).

For example:

- consideration, parenthood, belief, anger, love, care, freedom, envy etc.

**Abstract Nouns**

### ❖ CONCRETE NOUNS

**Concrete nouns are nouns that refer to things that exist physically and can be touched, seen, smelled, felt, or tasted.**

**Examples:**

- a) I have a cricket **bat** in my **closet**.
- b) The bat is made of **wood** from a **tree**.
- c) My brother has a mobile **phone**.
- d) I need some **water** for the **cake**.

**+ (Children, please do note that the same noun may fall under two categories at the same time. For eg., a bat is a Common as well as a Concrete Noun. Similarly, a pile of books is a Collective as well as a Concrete Noun at the same time)**
