Dear Children

You have learnt about the first three Kinds of Nouns- Common, Proper and Collective in Class III. Let's revise the first two of them here......

Common Nouns are the names of persons, places or things in general, such as, a boy, a book, a city, a school, a river and so on.

(Remember – Common Nouns do not begin with a capital letter, unless they appear at the beginning of a sentence)

LET'S REVISE

Nouns refer to naming words, that is, they name a person, place, animal or thing. Proper Nouns refer to specific names, that is, the name of a particular person, place, animal or thing, such as, Manish, Meeta, Jumbo, The Yamuna, The Bible, London and so on.

(Remember – Proper Nouns always begin with a capital letter)

KINDS OF NOUNS

<u>Common Nouns</u> - general names - eg. boy, table, book, city, almirah

<u>Proper Nouns</u> - particular names - eg. Anita, Delhi, LG, Ramayana


<u>Collective Nouns</u> - group names - eg. class, army, bouquet, flight of stairs

<u>Abstract Nouns</u> - thoughts, ideas, quality, feelings- eg. hunger, thickness, kindness, freedom, honesty
