- d) How did the Mole feel when he saw the river for the first time?(Hint: excited, surprised)


e) Do you think the Water Rat was a friendly animal? Give reasons for your answer.

MONUMENTS OF INDIA


Using MS Paint, draw any monument of India. You can use the various shape, Colour and Text Tool.


