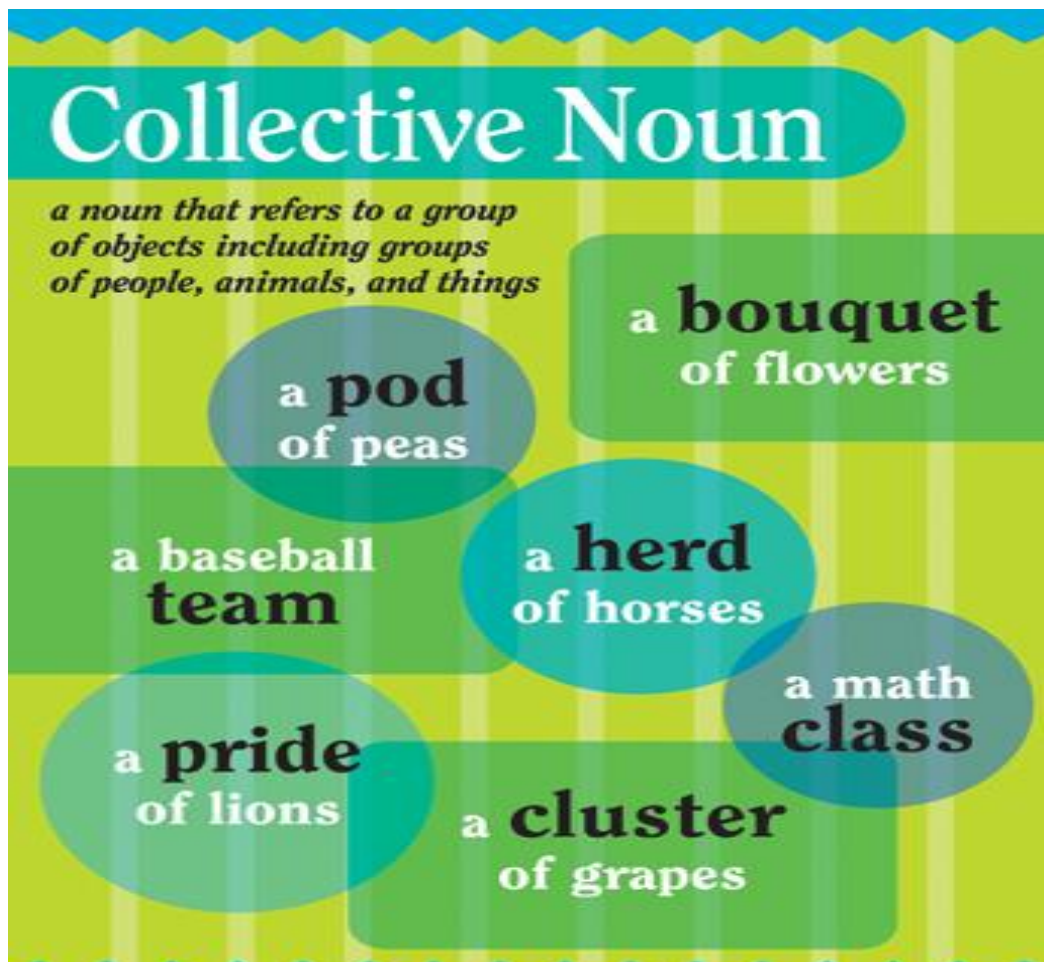

❖ **COLLECTIVE NOUNS**

Collective Nouns refer to groups of people, animals or things, such as, an audience, a family, a herd of cattle, a swarm of bees, a pile of books and so on.

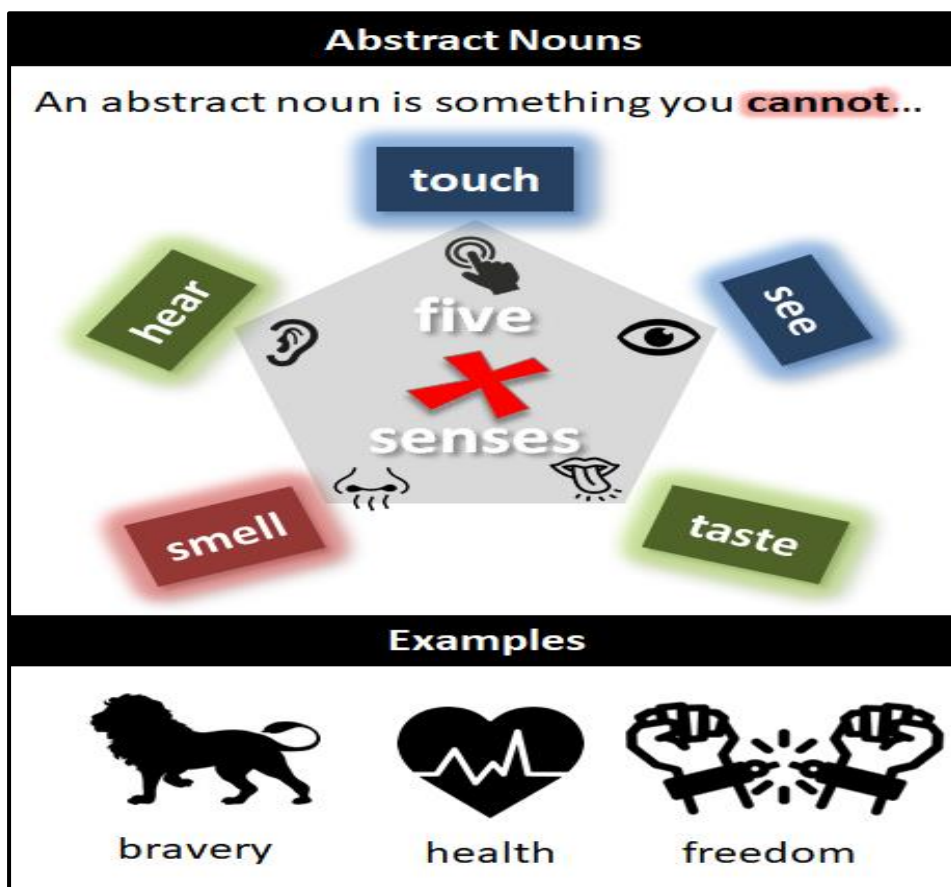

❖ **ABSTRACT NOUNS**

An abstract noun is a noun that refers to an emotion, a feeling, a quality, or an idea. In other words, an abstract noun does not refer to a physical object.

An abstract noun is a word that names something that you cannot see, hear, touch, smell, or taste (i.e., something you cannot observe with one of your five senses). For example:

- faith, friendship, parenthood, belief, anger, love, care, freedom, envy etc.
