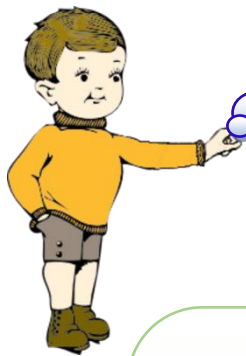
In the simplest sense, a noun is any word that names people, things, animals, places, events, or ideas.

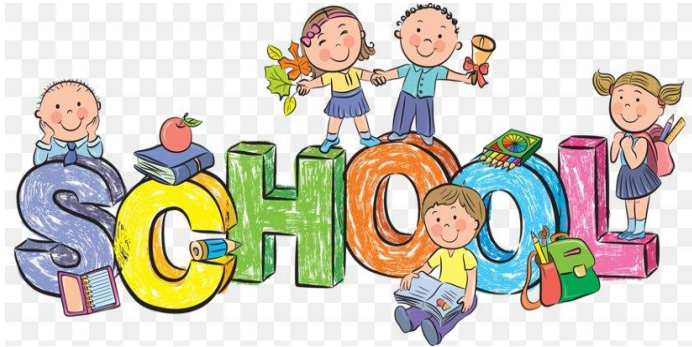


Common Noun
