



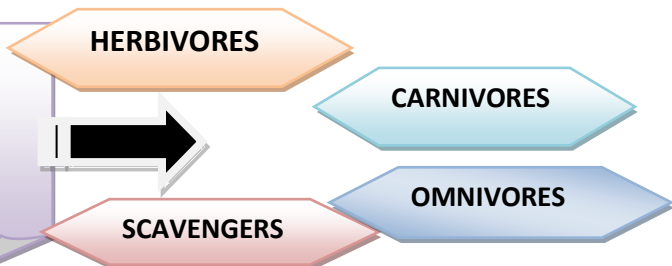

FOOD THAT ANIMALS EAT

Introduction:-

- **Animals cannot prepare their own food.**
- **They eat things found in their surroundings.**

Based on what they eat, animals can be divided into four groups:



HERBIVORES

- ▶ **They only eat plants.**
- ▶ **Their special teeth help them to bite & chew plants.**
- ▶ **They eat grass, leaves, fruits, seeds, grains and nuts.**



A rabbit eats carrots and other plants.

A cow eats grass.



A giraffe eats the leaves of a plant.

A hen eats seeds and grains.



A squirrel eats nuts.



Fun Facts:

- ▶ **Cows and buffaloes swallow their food without chewing.**
- ▶ **Later they bring it back to their mouth and chew it.**
- ▶ **This is called chewing the cud.**
