Let's revise the physical divisions:


The Northern Mountain

- Northern Mountains extend from Jammu and Kashmir to Arunachal Pradesh
- The Northern and Coastal Plains
- Northern plains stretch from Punjab to Assam
- Coastal Plains stretch from Gujarat to West Bengal

The Western Deserts Western desert stretches from Rann of Kachchh in Gujarat through Rajasthan to borders of Haryana

The Southern Plateaus

- Central Highlands stretch from Aravalli hills in the west to Rajmahal Hills in the East.
- Deccan Plateau stretches from River Narmada to the southern tip of the Indian Peninsula
- The Islands
- Andaman & Nicobar Islands in Bay of Bengal
- Lakshadweep Islands in Arabian Sea


