National Centre for Financial Education conducted National Financial Literacy Assessment Test (NFLAT) for the students of classes VI-X on 9th December, 2016. The test aimed at motivating students to learn the concepts of finance and to gauge their financial awareness. 51 students appeared for this test from our school out of which 41 students secured more than 50 percentile in the test and qualified as merit holders.

Vanshika Arora secured the sixth rank, Deepak Chopra secured the seventh rank and Parvesh Arora was ranked eleventh in the merit list.

The International Humming Bird English Olympiad was conducted in two levels. The first level was conducted on 30th November, 2016 where 111 students from classes VI-X participated. Twenty five children qualified for level II of the Olympiad exam. Ritwik Sharma of class VIII and Ramnit Kaur of class VIII bagged the first position at the school level and secured the fifteenth position at the National level.

ACADEMICS

Since the CBSE board examinations may begin from 15th February this session, extra classes were conducted for classes X and XII upto 26th May, 2017.

Remedial classes for children with special needs have been started. The classes are held every Tuesday and Friday. Members from our Parents' Support Group also come occasionally to help these students in coordination with the special educator.

Acknowledging the fact, an initiative has been taken to instil yoga in the morning routine of students from classes VI- VIII, thrice a week in the zero period.

To provide a platform for learning in a fun and enjoyable manner and develop spelling skills amongst pupils, the school has taken up the initiative of organising a Scrabble Challenge for the students of the Middle Department.
