A <mark>singular</mark> noun is <mark>one</mark> person, place, thing, or idea. Example: one boy. A plural noun is more than one person, place, thing, or idea. Example: many boys.

Singular	Plural	
a/one banana	two banana s	
an/one egg	two egg s	
an/one apple	a kilo of apples	
a/one baby	two bab ies	
a/one dress	three dress es	

Rules for changing Singular nouns into Plurals:

PLURAL NOUN = SINGULAR NOUN + 's'(usually)

Nouns that end in	Suffix to be added	Plural	
s, ss, sh, ch, x, o(Eg: bus, class, dish, watch, box, potato, tomato, volcano, hero)	+ es	buses, classes, dishes, watches, boxes, potatoes, tomatoes, volcanoes heroes	
<pre>consonant + y (family, baby, country)</pre>	change y to i+ es	families, babies, countries, cities	
f, fe(wife, wolf, knife)	change f to v +es	es wives, wolves, knives	
vowel + y (boy, toy)	+s	boys,toys	
Nouns ending with a vowel+o	+s	radios, dynamos (exception to this rule: photo-photos)	

<u>IRREGULAR NOUNS</u> (These nouns become plural by changing their spellings in ways other than the usual rules given above or they don't change their spellings at all)

Examples:-

- man -men
- woman women
- child children
- tooth teeth
- foot feet
- person people
- sheep sheep
- fish fish
- mouse mice
- goose geese
- louse lice
- ox oxen
- deer deer
