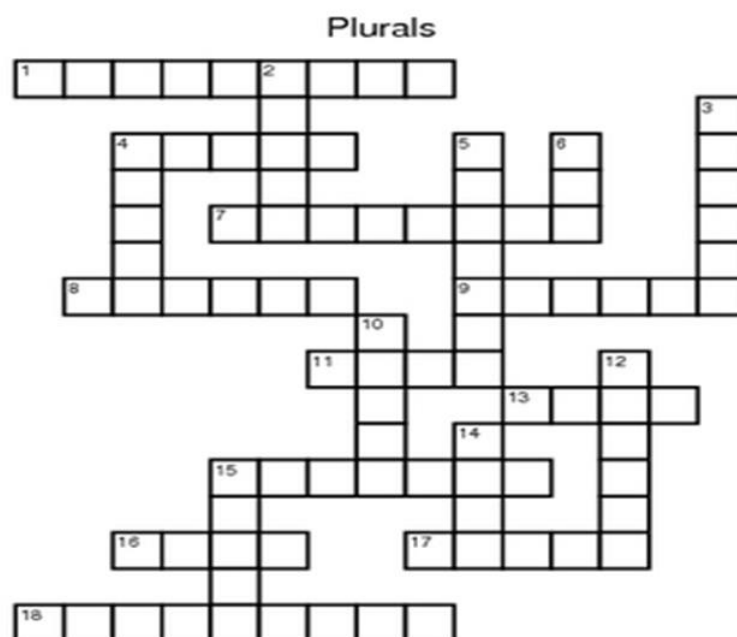




Dear children...You have revised the concept of Nouns (Number) in Part I and II of this lesson. Let's now practise some exercises to strengthen the concept learnt.
