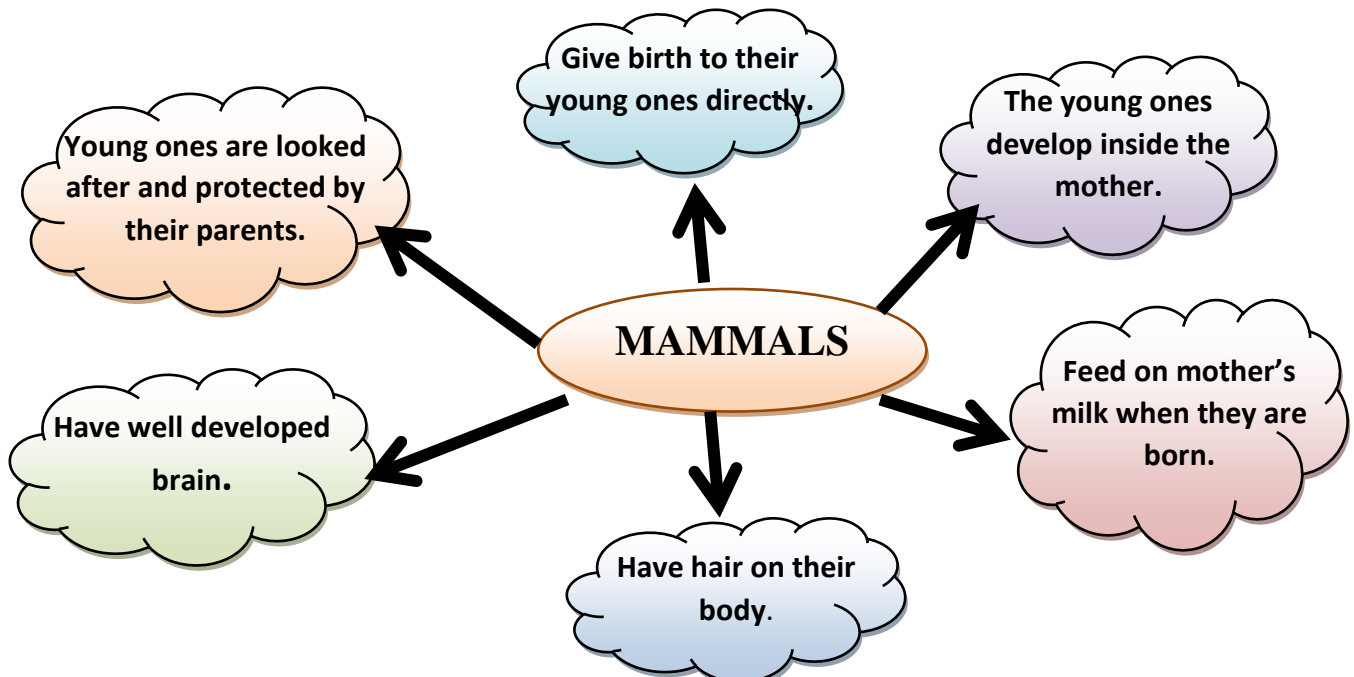

Mammals are warm blooded. This means that they are able to keep their body roughly at the same temperature no matter what the surrounding temperature is.

For example: normal body temperature of a human being is always between 97.7°F -99.5°F or 36.5°C – 37.5°C.
