Egg Laying Animals(Oviparous Animals)

Few animals can reproduce by laying eggs. The young one develops inside the egg and comes out from it by hatching.

Examples:

BIRDS

They build nests to lay eggs. They sit on the eggs to keep them warm. This is called hatching.

FROGS

They lay their eggs in water. A frog's egg develops into a tadpole.

FISHES

A fish lays thousands of eggs in water. From these only a few hatch as rest are eaten up by big fish.

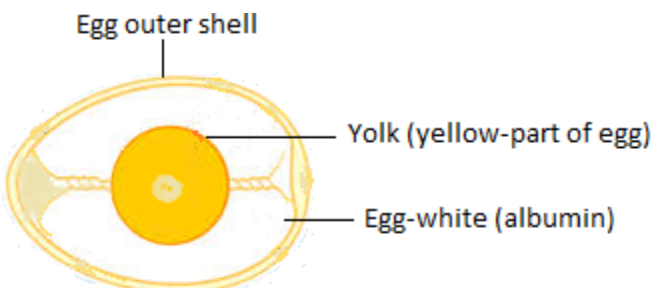
INSECTS

All insects hatch from eggs. Adult insects do not look after their babies.

REPTILES

Reptiles like lizards, turtles and snakes lay their eggs in holes in the ground. Some eggs get warmth from the heat of the sun and hatch.

STRUCTURE OF AN EGG



a. **Shell:** It is the outermost hard layer. It protects the content of an egg. The shell can be white or brown.

b. **Albumin:** It is white and watery part of an egg which protects the baby bird. It is rich in protein.

c. **Yolk:** It is yellow in colour which provides food to the growing baby.

d. **Embryo:** A growing baby chick inside an egg is called an EMBRYO. It takes 21 days for a chick to come out of an egg.
