## Topic 6 - Do/Does/Did (Verbs)(Part II)

#### Dear Students

- ➤ This lesson will give you an introduction to the verbs Do/Does/Did Questions (Part II)
- The lesson is divided into two parts. The <u>first part</u> is a lesson on Do/Does/Did. The <u>second part</u> is a <u>vocabulary exercise</u> for you to practice. (Not to be done in the English notebook)
- Go through the lesson carefully and attempt the <u>exercise on Do/Does/Did</u> given at the end, in your notebook.
- You need NOT copy the notes in your English notebook.

#### I. INTRODUCTION -

#### DO / DOES in Questions

To make a question in the *Simple Present Tense*, the auxiliary *Do* or *Does* is put at the beginning of the question <u>before the subject</u>. Do not miss the question mark.

• We add **Do** at the beginning of the affirmative sentence to change it into a question.

Examples:

Affirmative: You speak English.

**Question**: **Do** you speak English?

Affirmative: He likes chocolates.

**Question**: Does he like chocolates?

**NOTE:** There can be other words before **DO** and **Does** such as question words (who, what, where etc.)

#### DID in Questions

To make questions in the *past tense*, the auxiliary **DID** is normally put at the beginning of the question or before the main subject. There can be question words (why, where, what etc) before **Did**.

**NOTE –** With 'Did' you **always** use the <u>first form</u> of the verb, whether in statements, or questions.

#### **Examples:**

- a) **Did** he call you?
- b) **Did** Mr. Robert attend the meeting?
- c) **Did** the guest arrive late?

## II. RECAPITULATION OF THE PREVIOUS LESSON -

In the previous lesson on Do/Does/Did (Dated- 24th April 2020), we learnt that -

- Forms of the verb **To Do** 
  - ❖ Present Tense Do/Does
  - ❖ Past Tense -Did
- **Do** and **Does** are the <u>present form</u> of the verb **Do** which is used in Present Simple form.

I/ you / we / they – Do

He/ she/ it – Does

- **Do** is used with plural nouns in the present tense.
- **Does** is used in the case of third person singular. *Example*: He, she, it, Rohan, dog, tree etc.
- **Don't** and **Doesn't** are normally used to make negative sentences in the present tense.
- **Did** is used with both <u>singular</u> and <u>plural</u> nouns in the past tense.
- In the past tense 'didn't' is used to make a negative sentence for all subjects (I, you, we, he, they, she, it)


