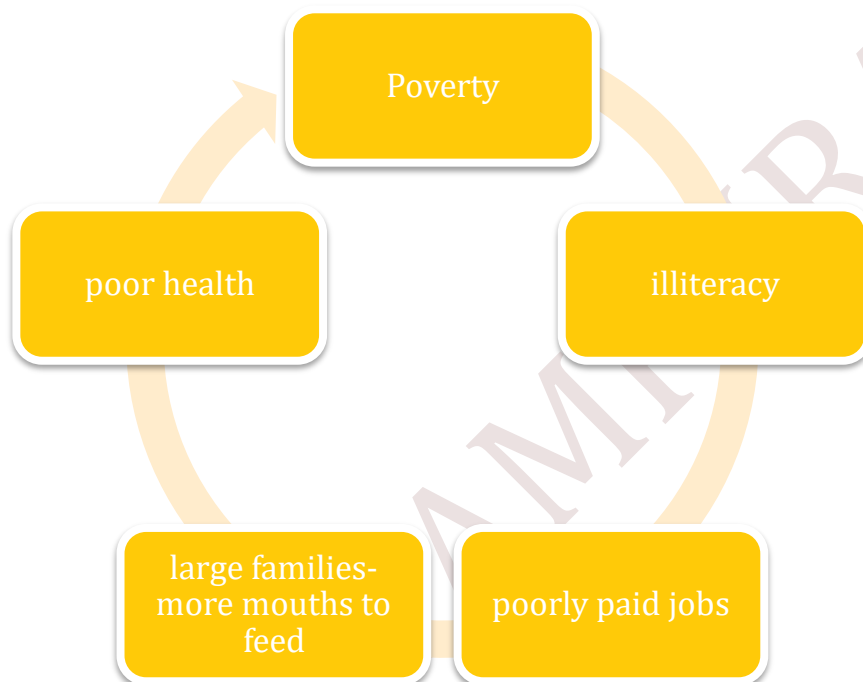

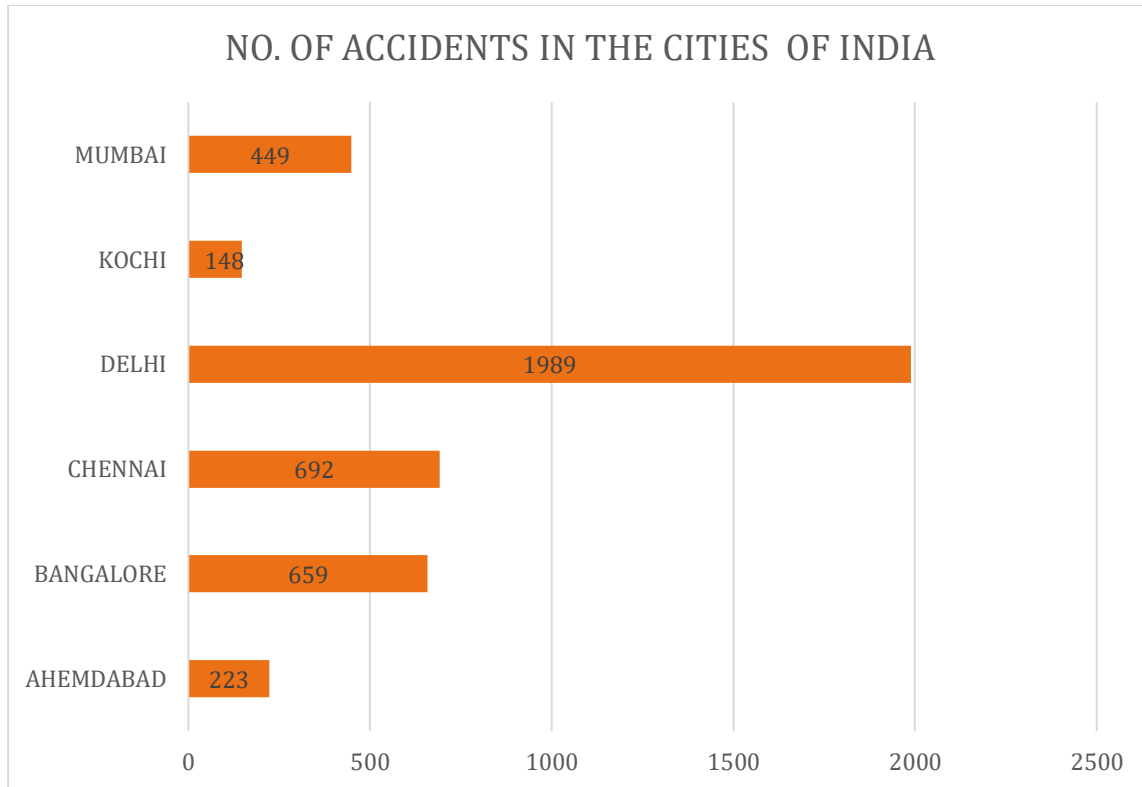
### **THE VICIOUS CIRCLE OF POVERTY**

The drawback of large families with one member earning and so many mouths to be fed further aggravates the problem.
