To make learning how to speak German, easier there are some rules :

- German vowels are not same as English vowels.
- The double dots above vowels are called UMLAUTS.

Umlauts: Your mouth is about to do some crazy gymnastics.

A = ah..... as in " father"

E = eh.....as in " hair"

I = ee..... as in " week"

O = oh

U = oo.....as in " spooky"

ä = eh.....as in " every"

Ö = oe

ü = ue

ß is just like " ss " sound. The actual name of this letter is " eszet"

J sounds like the English Y

V sounds like the English F
