

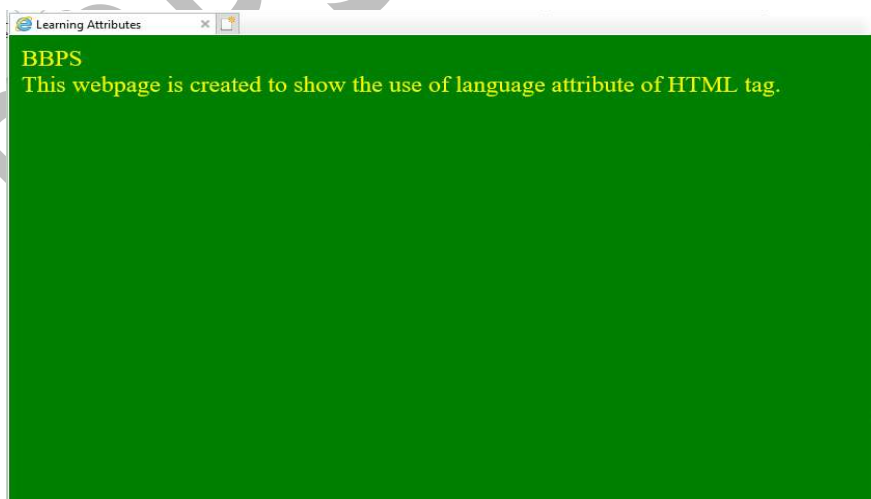


- Tags are coded commands in HTML, also known as elements.
- The HTML document begins with `<html>` and ends with `</html>`.
- The visible part of the HTML document is between `<body>` and `</body>`.
- An HTML attribute provides additional information about an HTML element.
- Attributes usually come in name/value pairs like: **name="value"**.
- The lang Attribute-The language of the document can be declared in the `<html>` tag. The language is declared with the **lang** attribute. Value of lang attribute is code of language the webpage is to be displayed like en for English

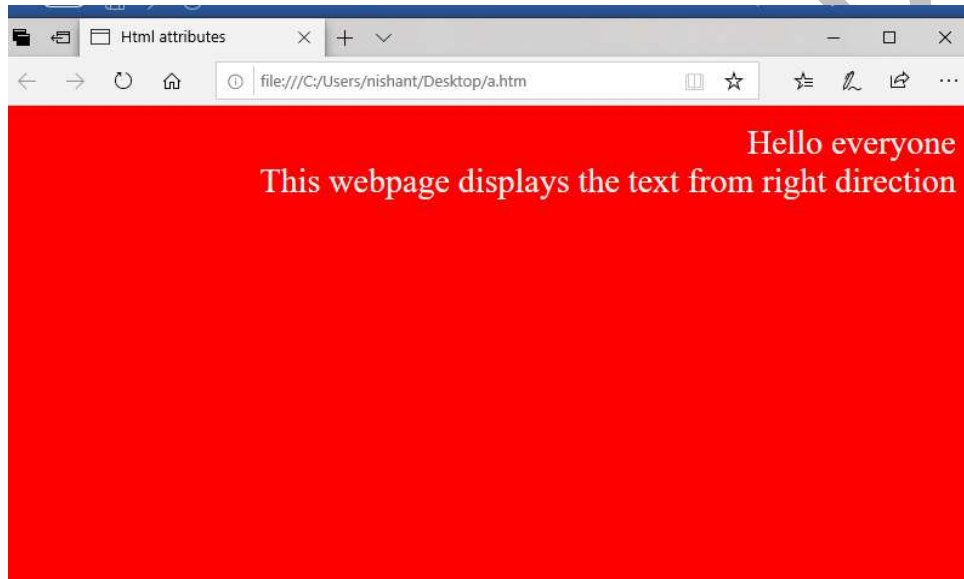


- The dir Attribute-The dir attribute specifies the text direction of the element's content. Two values of dir attribute are ltr-left to right(by default) and rtl-right to left.
