• Global Citizenship Education (GCED) programme

• SAFETY DRIVE

WORLD LITERACY DAY

After the Literacy campaign students were given worksheet related to Literacy day and they were also given badges which were coloured by the students and it was stapled on the pockets so that when they go home they could discuss the Literacy campaign of "Each One Teach One" with their parents. the Literacy day elicited good response.

WORLD PEACE DAY

Gandhi Jayanti / World Peace Day activity was organized on 1st October, 2019 for the Pre-Primary children. The children were briefed about Gandhiji and his ideals of peace and non-violence.
