FOR CLASS XI and XII

Academic Session 2020-21

Every student must have a minimum of 75% attendance failing which he/she will not be allowed to sit in the final examination/will not be promoted to the next higher class.

Please discourage the student from missing an exam unless on grounds of extreme emergency like a contagious disease, fracture etc. for which a medical certificate from a certified government hospital practitioner and supporting medical reports must be submitted within one week of the absence.

PASS CRITERIA (SENIOR SCHOOL CERTIFICATE EXAMINATION)

In order to be declared as having passed the Class XI Examination, a candidate shall obtain 33% marks in all the subjects cumulatively and 33% individually in each subject also in the annual exams. The pass marks in each subject of examination shall be 33%.

In case of any subject involving practical work, a candidate must obtain 33% marks in theory and 33% in practical separately, in addition to 33% marks in aggregate in order to qualify in that subject. (From CBSE examination Byelaws)

For additional subjects: It is mandatory to pass in the additional subject in class XI to continue the same in class XII.

ELIGIBILITY FOR COMPARTMENT IN SENIOR SCHOOL CERTIFICATE EXAMINATION

A candidate failing in any one of the five subjects of external examination shall be placed in compartment in that subject, provided he/she qualifies in all other subjects of internal assessment. (From CBSE examination Byelaws)

DETENTION:

a) Class-XI (After annual exam) :	A child scoring less than 33% in two or more than two subjects will be declared
b) Class-XI (Detention after retest):	detained. If a child fails to fulfill all the following two conditions:

- i. Minimum 33% in the Retest Exam (Weightage 60%)
- Minimum 33% in the cumulative aggregate annual result (10% of CT-I, 20% of HY, 10% of CT-2 and 60% of Retest of Annual Examination)

MISSED/RETEST EXAMS (FOR CLASS XI & XII)

- a) If a student has missed any exam (except On Duty), no average shall be given i.e student will be marked zero and there shall be no retest.
- b) If a student is On Duty or has missed the exam due to genuine medical reasons, retest shall be conducted only once and shall be held as per the declared schedule.

USE OF UNFAIR MEANS

If during the course of the examination, a student is found indulging in any kind of unfair practice, the exam will stand cancelled. He/she will have to appear for a retest in the subject and 10 marks (out of 100) will be deducted from the theory paper as penalty for the same.

Note: The Promotion Policy is subject to change as per the latest guidelines issued by DOE/ CBSE.
