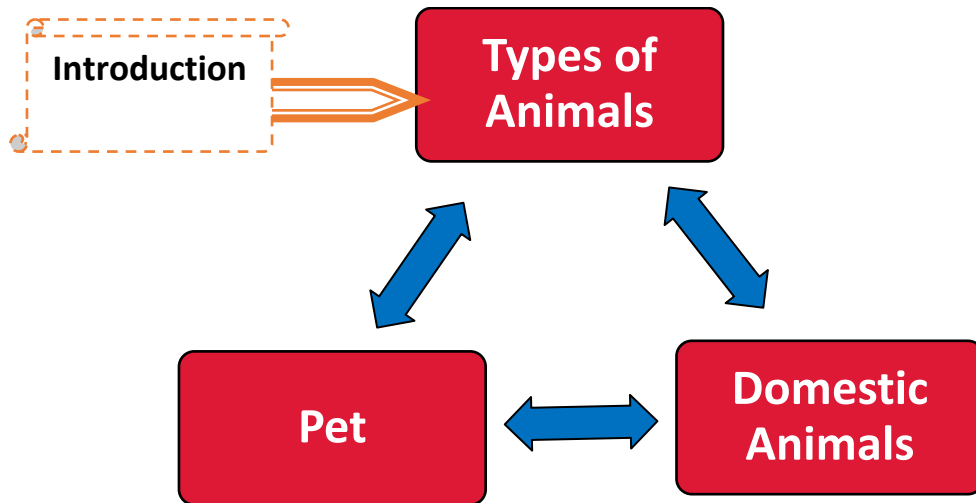

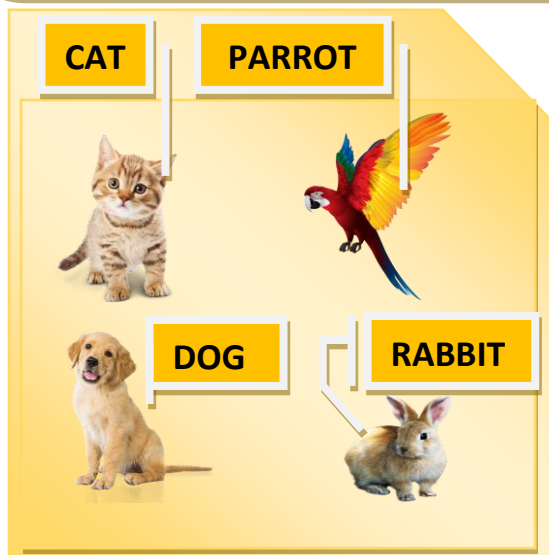

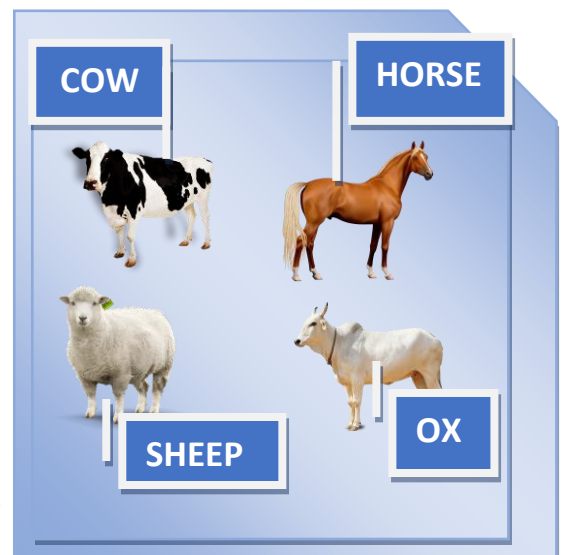
PETS
