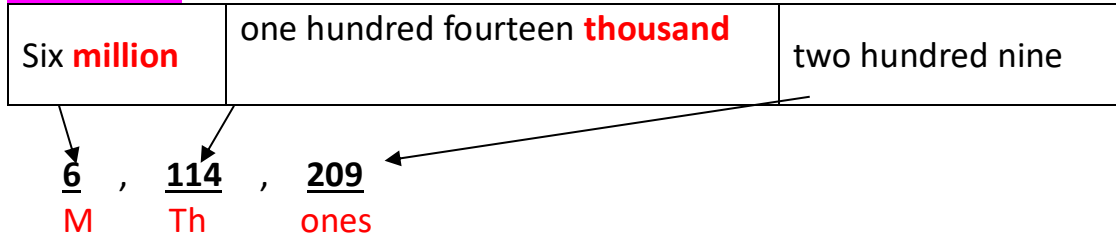

We read it as

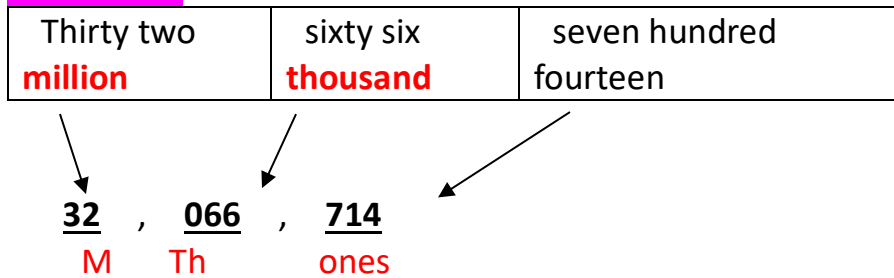
Forty five million, one hundred twenty nine thousand, six hundred eighty two.
