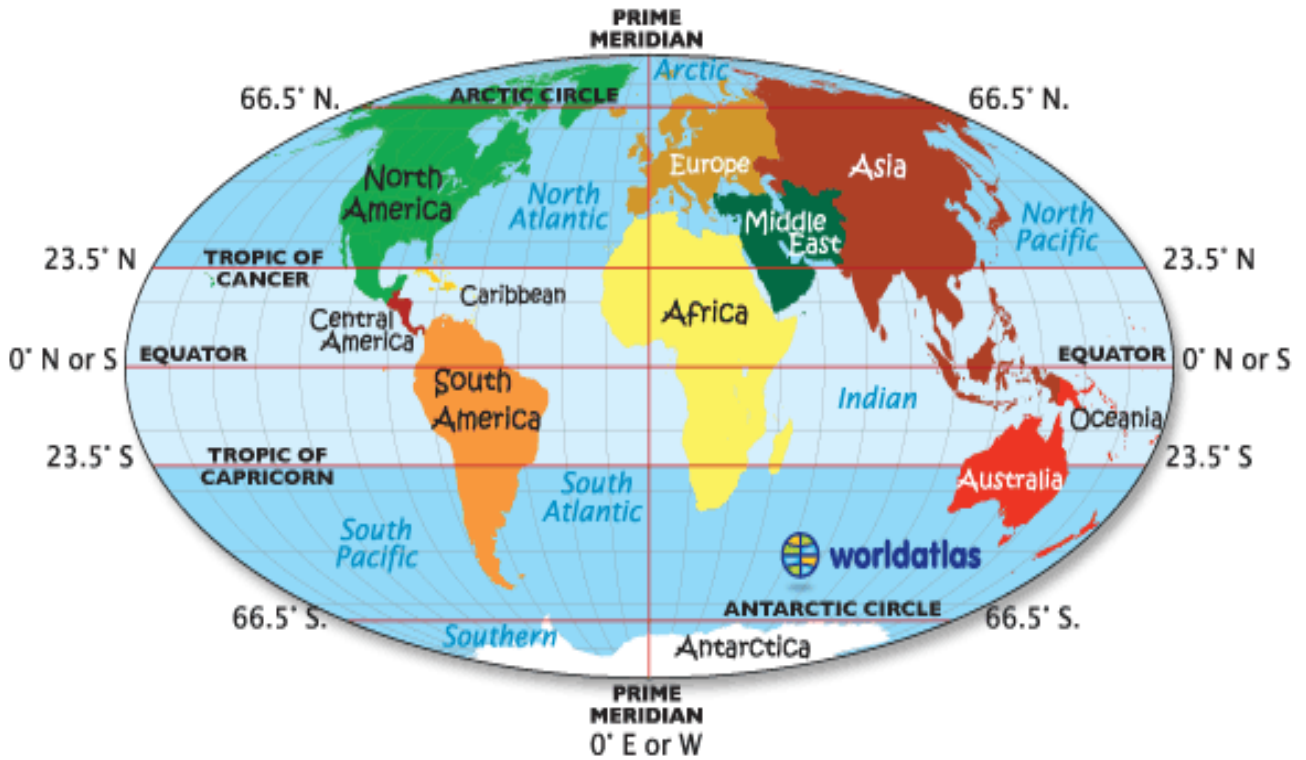

The imaginary lines running from North to South are known as Meridians or Lines of Longitudes.

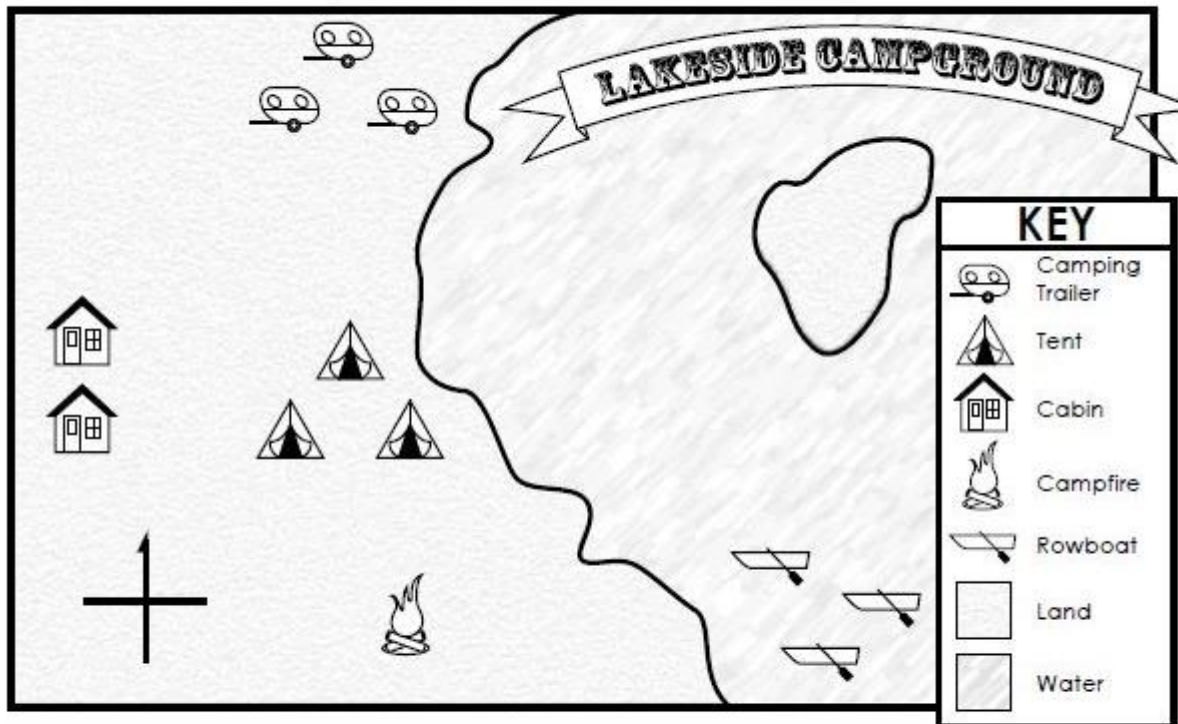


- a. Find out the imaginary line passing through our country India.
