POINTS TO REMEMBER

- ❖ **Purvachal Hill Ranges** are also called **North-eastern Hills**.
- ❖ They lie in the **North-eastern part** of India.
- ❖ The states lying in the region are called the '**Seven Sisters**'. These states are-
 - ✓ Arunachal Pradesh
 - ✓ Nagaland
 - ✓ Manipur
 - ✓ Mizoram
 - ✓ Tripura
 - ✓ Meghalaya
 - ✓ Assam (**part of Northern plains**)
