Terrace farming is a method of farming in which “steps” known as terraces are built onto the slopes of hills and mountains. When it rains, instead of rain carrying away the soil nutrients and plants down the slope, they flow to the next terrace. Every step has an outlet which channels water to the next step. Soil erosion occurs when the water with high speed runs down washing the soil. As many terrace or step- like slopes are present in terrace farming it reduces the speed as well as the quantity of water moving over the soil surface. This checks soil erosion.
