(Note: All the given work is to be done on ruled A4 sheets)

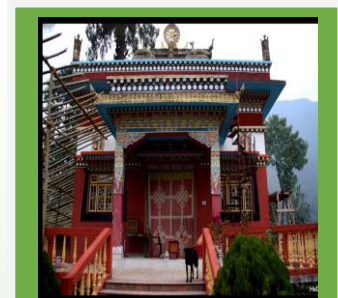
