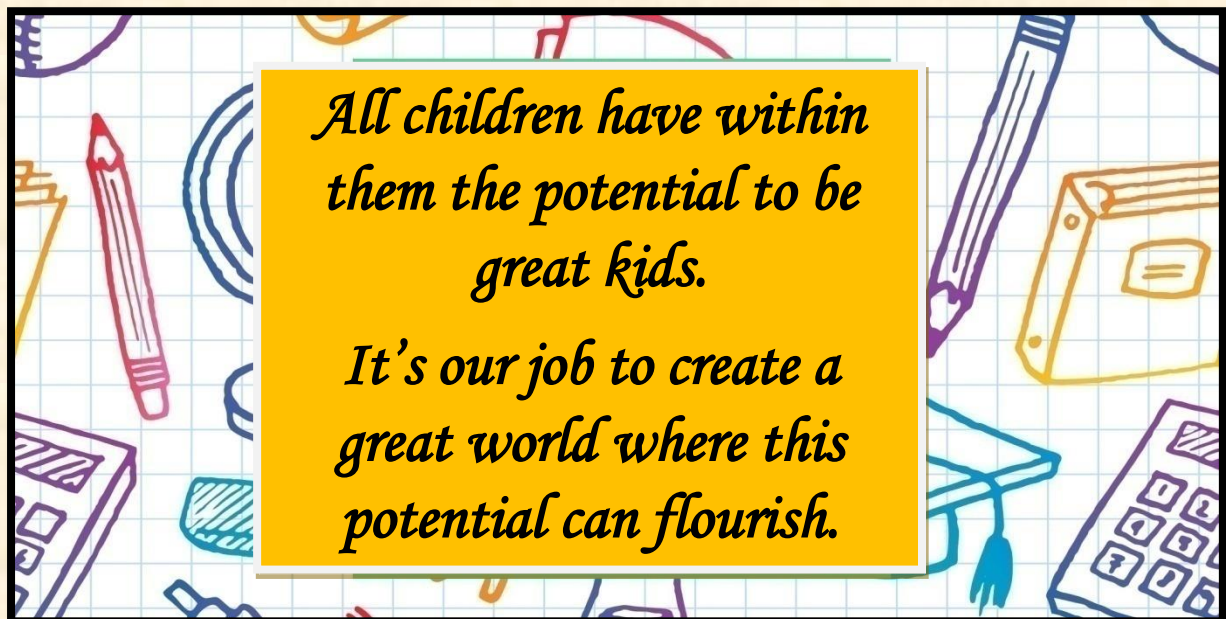

**Note :** Use separate A4 sheets for the given work and put them in a folder.



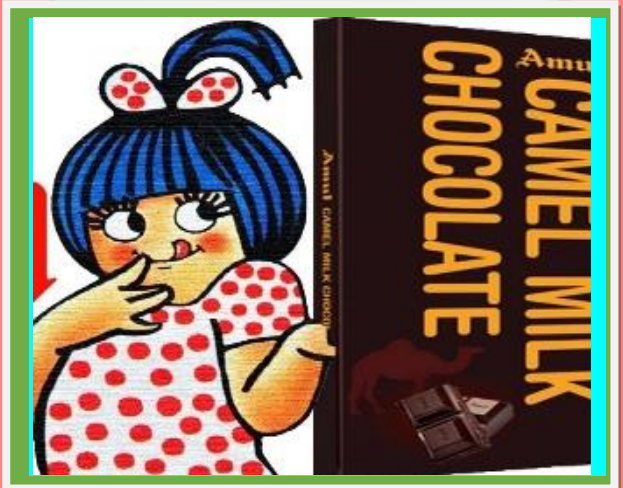
