

PRE PRIMARY ACTIVITIES

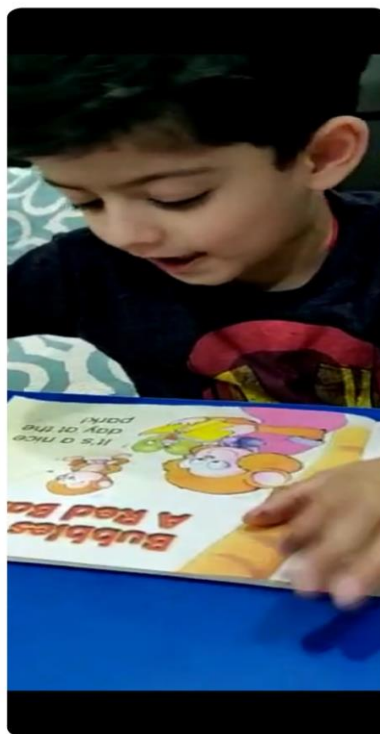
1. LITTLE WARRIORS ACTIVITIES RELATED TO COVID-19 (3.4.2020)

3. EARTH DAY ACTIVITY

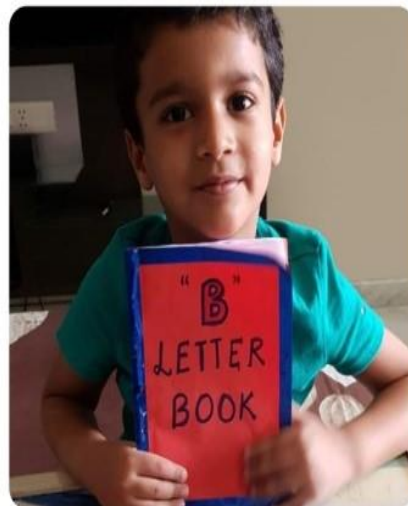
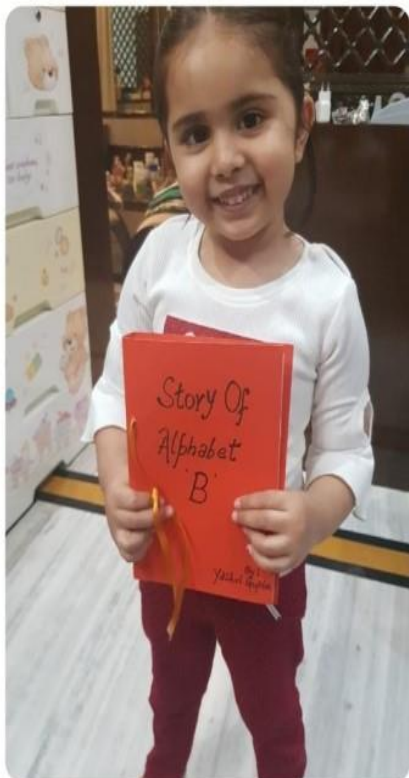
Earth day was celebrated on 22.4.2020. Parents and children were asked to do a role play in which children learn “Do not waste paper” and to recycle it by using it again.
