

Services in a Neighbourhood

A good neighbourhood has many useful services. These services help to make our lives easy and comfortable.

School

Children go to school to learn to read, write and play. They also learn good habits and manners there.

Post Office

A post office sells postcards, envelopes and stamps. We can send letters, postcards, money orders and parcels through it.

We post our letters in a postbox.

A postman takes them to a post office.

The post office sends the letters to different places. A postman delivers these letters to us.

We do not post parcels or money orders in a postbox. We send them directly through a post office.

Hospital

A hospital takes care of people who are sick or injured. Doctors and nurses look after the patients. A hospital has an ambulance to bring sick and injured people and give them immediate care.



Fact Ant

A nursing home or a clinic is smaller than a hospital and has fewer facilities.



Police Station

A big neighbourhood has a police station. The police help us when we are in trouble. They guard our neighbourhood and keep our lives and belongings (things we have) safe.

Fire Station

When there is a fire, we call the fire brigade from the fire station. A fire engine carries firefighters, water, hose and ladders to put out fires.



Fact Ant

Firefighters wear special clothes that do not catch fire.

Market

A market has many shops. Different shops sell fruits, vegetables, books, clothes and other things of daily need.





Library

A library has books for people to read or borrow.
A librarian is a person who works in a library.

Bank

We keep our money and other valuables in a bank for safety. A bank also lends money to people.



Places of Recreation

Recreation means to enjoy or relax. We can do many things for recreation. We can go to a park, zoo, aquarium or circus with our family and friends.



Park

A park is a place where people go to walk, play and relax. Children have fun on swings, slides and see-saws.

Zoo
