EVOLUTION OF MONEY

There was no concept of money in ancient times. People used to exchange services and goods for other services and goods in return. This system of exchanging goods to fulfil everyday needs was called Barter System. The Barter system had some limitations. So slowly Money was invented. It first came in the form of metal coins. Then slowly with time Paper Money was invented.


