



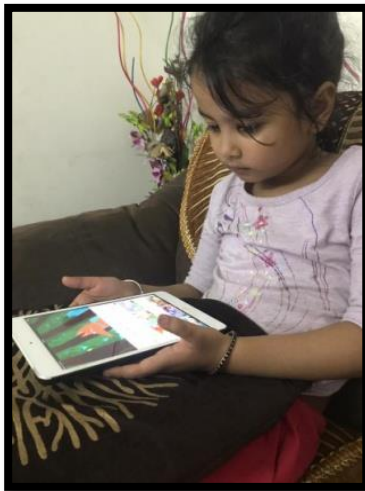

They read books of their choice and gain the much-required confidence.



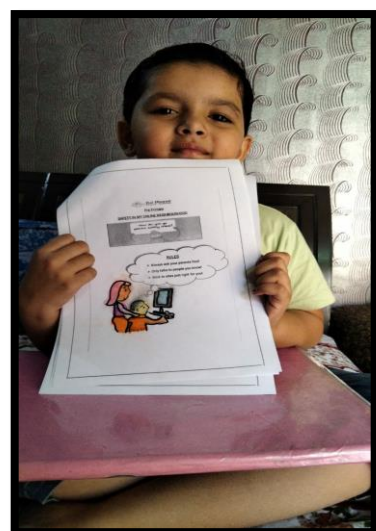
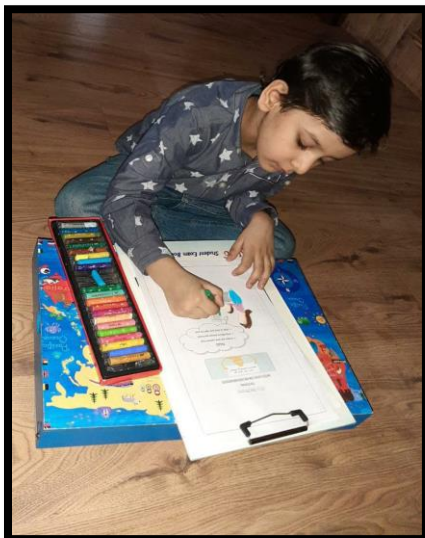
SAFETY IN MY ONLINE NEIGHBOURHOOD

Following Guidelines were discussed -

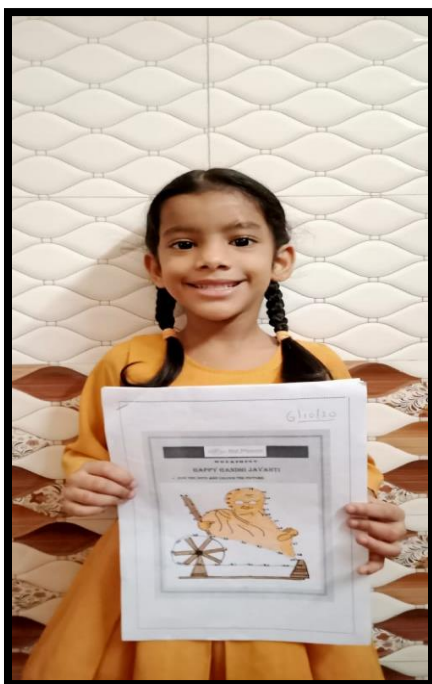
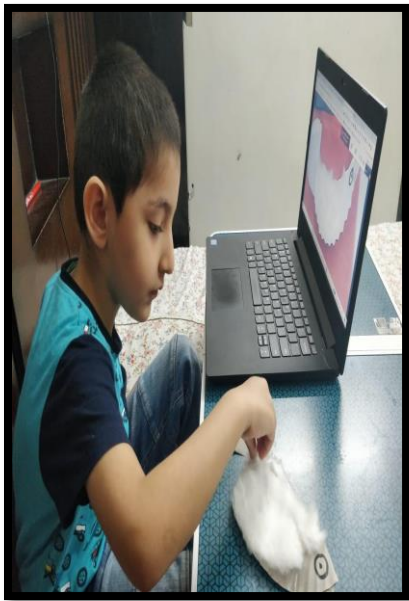
- Never talk to strangers on social media...
