

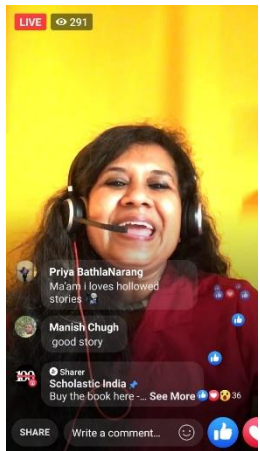

- ❖ **Interview of Our Elderly/Grandparents to Explore the Changes in Our Environment Based on Human Activities-**

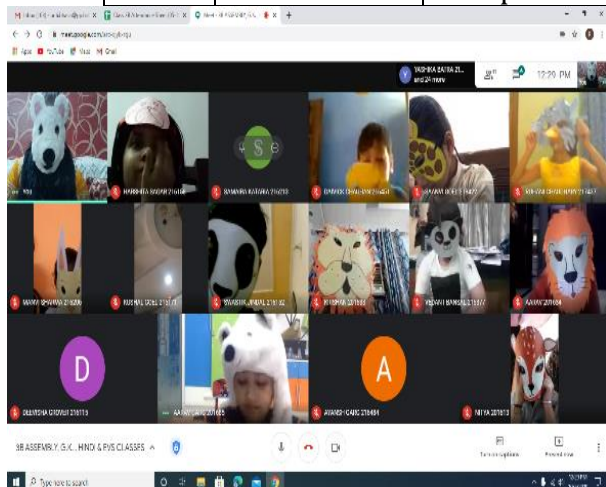

HIGHLIGHTS OF THE MONTH:

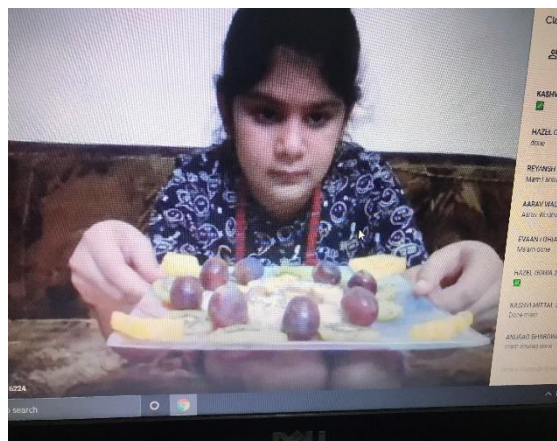

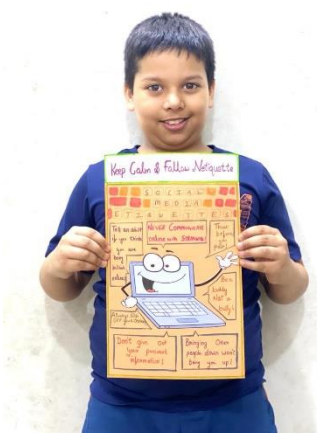
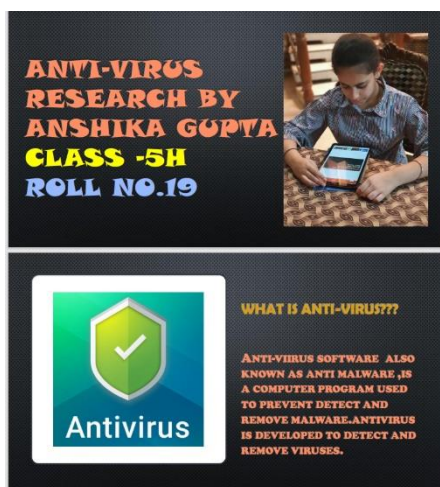
❖ **Word Power Activities:-**
