



Saurav Sahoo- class X (2019-20) has made the school proud by clearing the first level of NTSE Exam (organized by the **Government** of NCT of Delhi).




When the physical world seemed unapproachable, we knocked the doors of the virtual world.


ENGLISH LANGUAGE PROGRAM

Students were urged to use cotton thread for flying kites to celebrate festivals, as per the guidelines issued by Govt. of NCT of Delhi.


Eco-friendly Ganesha idols made with biodegradable material such as atta, maida, and paper on the occasion of Ganesh Chaturthi.


PINNACLE CLUB


