Weather and Seasons

Even summer

The weather is not the same on all days. It keeps changing from day to day. It may be hot, cold, windy, cloudy or rainy. Change in weather is caused by sun, wind, clouds and rain.

When one type of weather continues for many days, we call it a **season**. Summer, monsoon and winter are the three main seasons in our country.

Summer (hot and sunny)

In summer, the sun shines very brightly and it is very hot. Days are long and nights are short. We sweat a lot and feel thirsty all the time. We like to have cold water, cold drinks and juices. We like to wear cotton clothes. Some people go to the hill stations in summer. Hot winds called loo blow in summer.



Monsoon (rainy and cloudy)

Monsoon brings rain. The weather is cloudy and cool winds blow all the time. We can hear thunder and see lightning in the sky. We use an umbrella or wear a raincoat and gumboots when we go out. They protect us from rain. Sometimes we see a rainbow in the sky.

Winter (cold)

We feel cold in winter. Days become short and nights are long. Mountains and hilly areas have snowfall. We use blankets and quilts to keep ourselves warm. We wear woollen clothes and use heaters or light a fire to stay warm. We like to have hot drinks and hot food.

Some places also experience autumn and spring.

Autumn (dry and windy)

In autumn, the weather is neither too hot nor too cold. It is dry and windy. Dry leaves fall from trees.



Spring (pleasant)

The weather in this season is pleasant. It is neither too hot nor too cold. It is the season of flowers and butterflies. Spring is called *basant* in Hindi.
