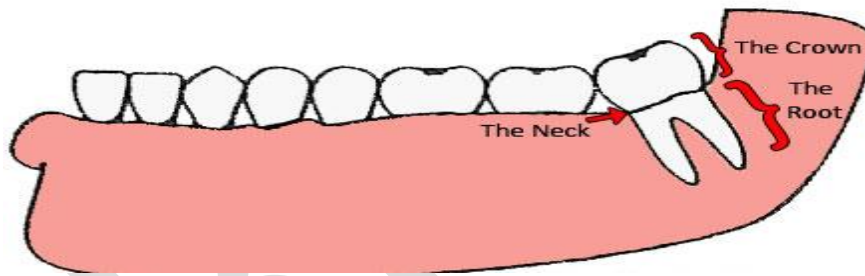

STRUCTURE OF A TOOTH

A tooth that is visible in our mouth is only a part of the entire tooth. A tooth is made up of three parts:



The crown

It is the visible part of a tooth above the gums.

The root

This is the part of the tooth that we cannot see. It lies deep inside the gums. The root holds the tooth in the jaw.

The neck

The part between the crown and the root is the neck.

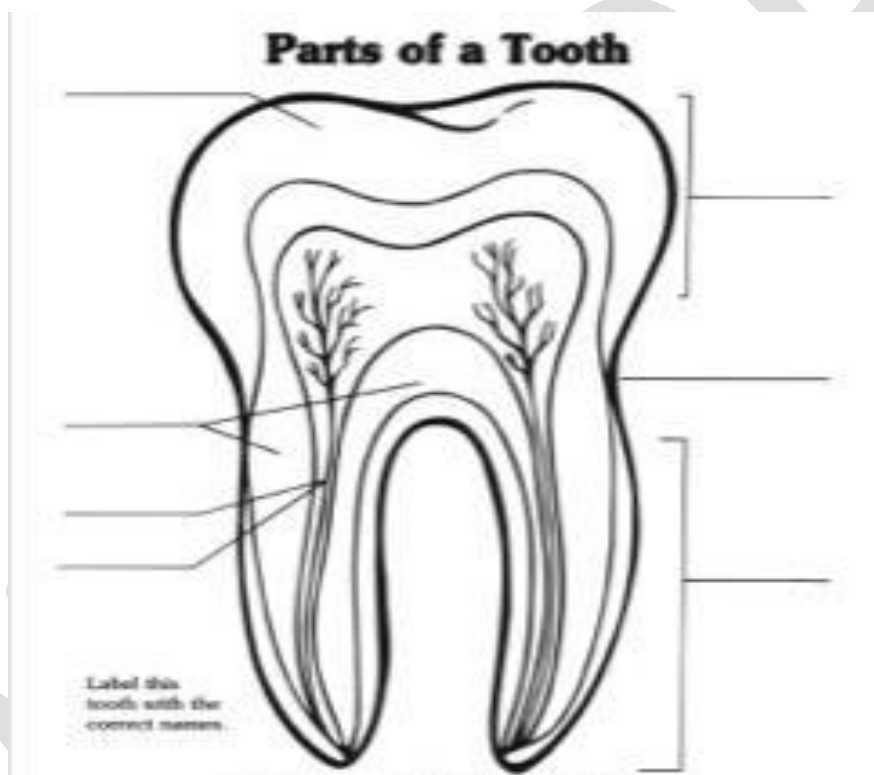
