**Les Nationalités**

Every country has an adjective that can be used to describe people and things from that country. These adjectives are called nationalities.

I am from France.

I am French.

So French is a nationality.



In English, there is only one form of nationality for e.g. An **Indian** boy, An **Indian** girl, Some **Indian** boys, Some **Indian** girls.

But in French, they can have up to 4 forms, according to the gender and number of the nouns they modify:

## Prominent features of nationalities

- ✓ **Nationalities always correspond with the gender of the person – masculine or feminine.**

Par exemple-

Français	Anglais
Le garçon est <b>indien</b>	The boy is Indian
La fille est <b>indienne</b>	The girl is Indian

- ✓ **Nationalities always correspond with number of persons– singular and plural.**

Français	Anglais
Les garçons sont <b>indiens</b>	The boys are Indian
Les filles sont <b>indiennes</b>	The girls are Indian

Some more examples:

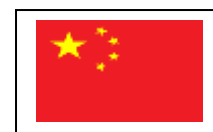
- ❖ Le professeur est de Canada. Il est **canadien**.

(The teacher is from Canada. He is Canadian)



- ❖ Ma mère est de Chine. Elle est **chinoise**.

(My mother is from China. She is Chinese)



- ❖ Elles habitent en Italie. Elles sont **italiennes**.

(They live in Italy. They are Italian)



The list of important nationalities is given below.

Pakistan	Le Pakistan	pakistanais	pakistanaise	Pakistani

**Note:** The plural of nationalities is formed by adding an **S** to the singular masculine or feminine form.
