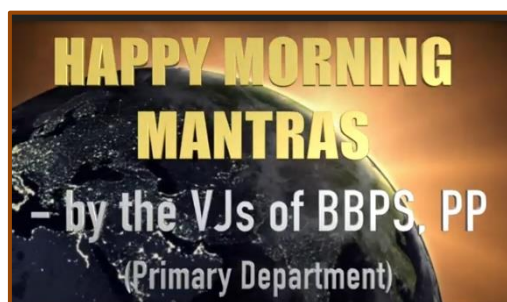




❖ **Morning Mantras:-**

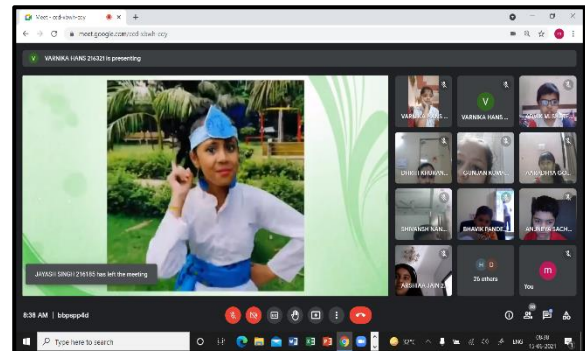
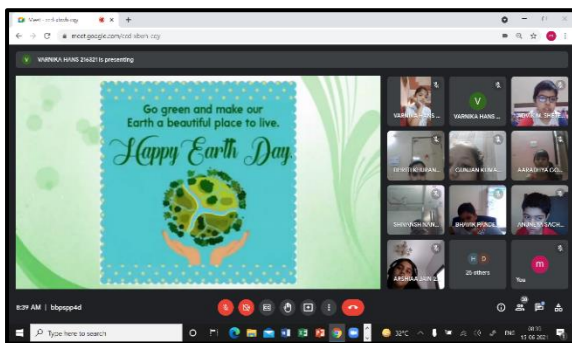
## ❖ Special Assembly – World Health Day:-

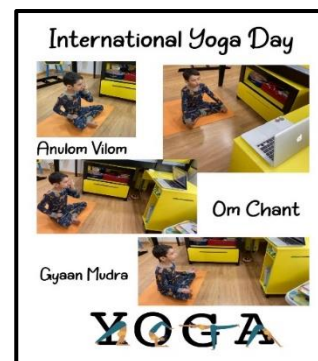
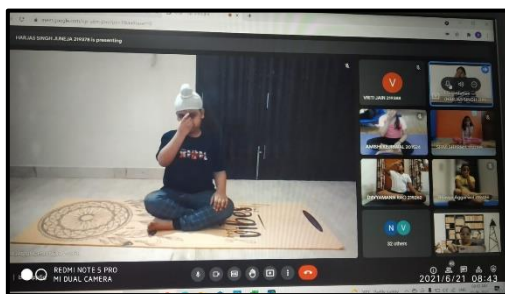
## ❖ Special Assembly – World Environment Day:-

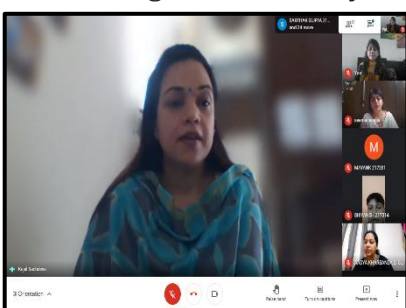
❖ **Other Activities:-**

❖ **Meloria – Pursuit of the Better – Newsletter – Primary Department:-**

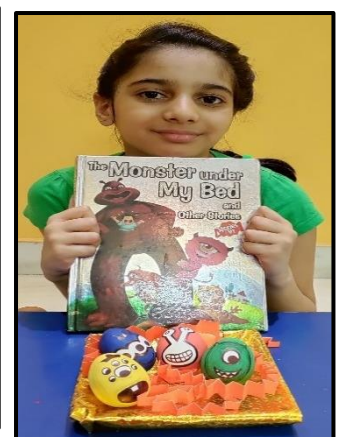
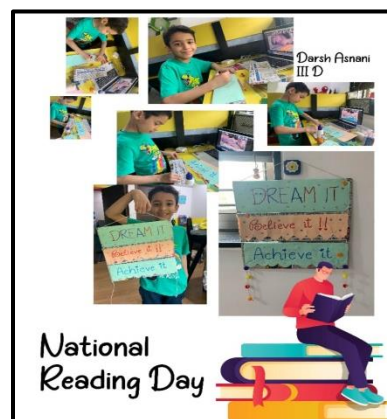
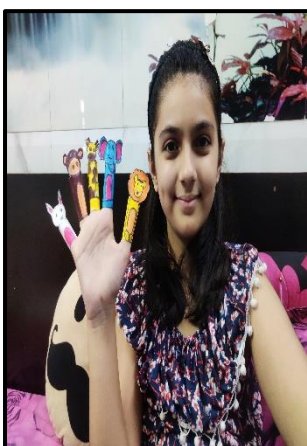
