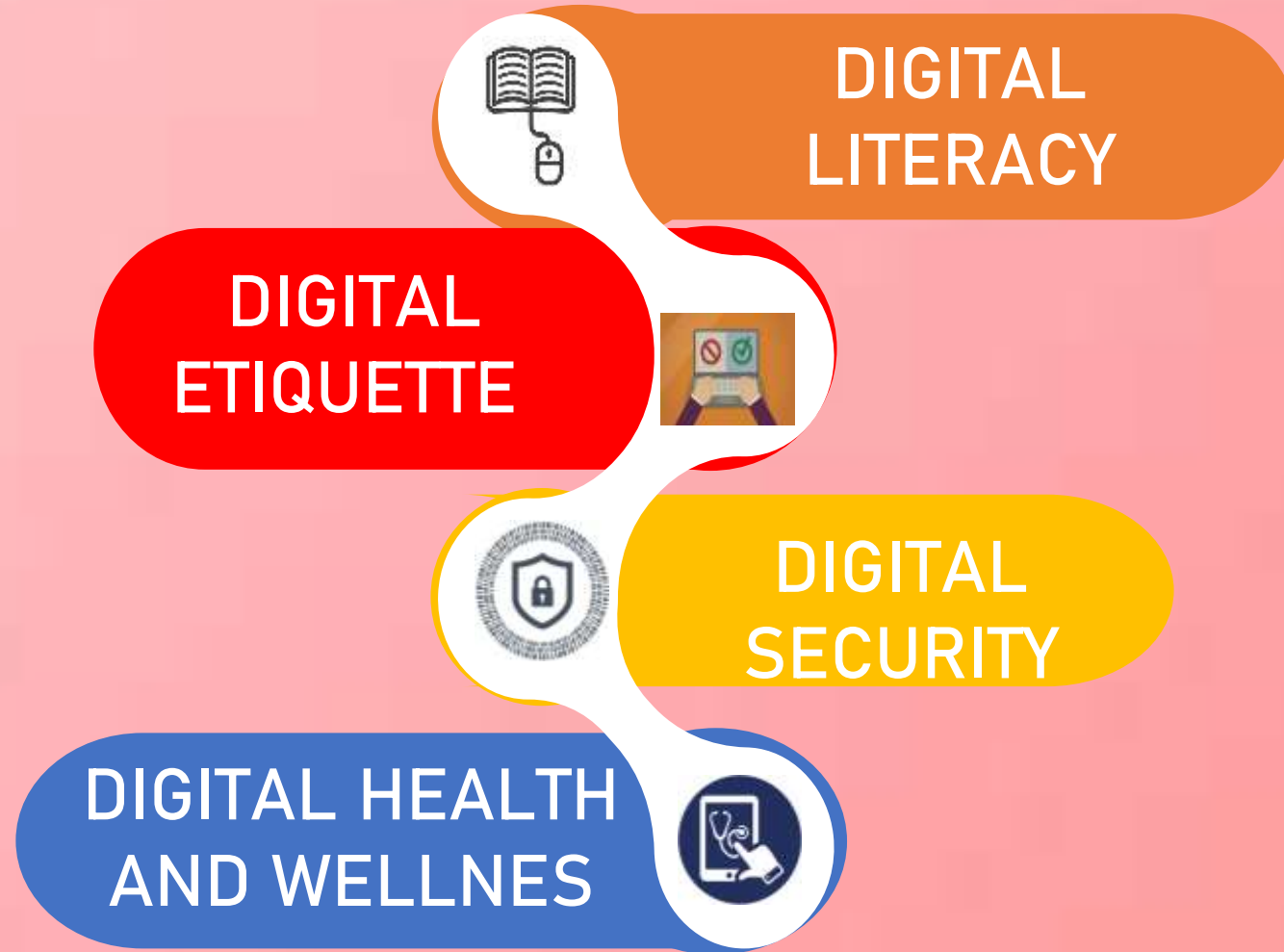
# PINNACLE CLUB

**Sadak Suraksha, Jeevan Raksha!!**

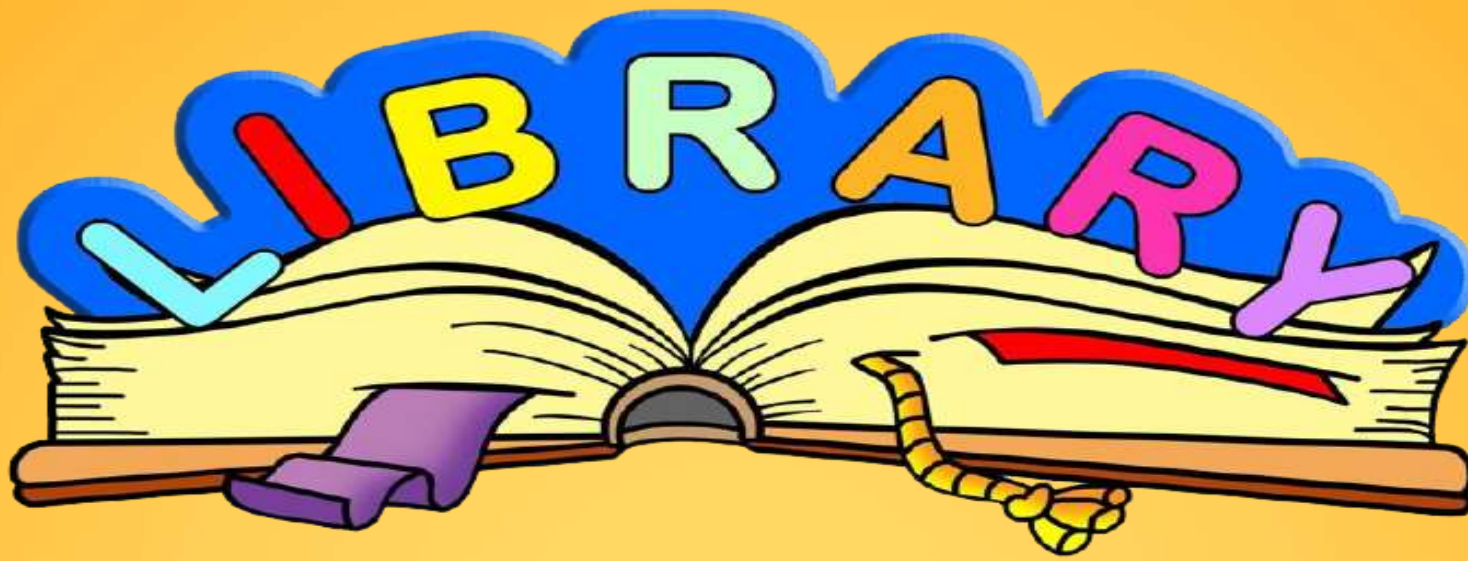
**The club conducted various activities for the students of Classes III to IX on 'Road Safety Awareness'.**
