

Q2. WIND FARMS


The stronger the wind, the faster the windmill blades rotate and the greater the electric power output. However, there is not a direct relationship between wind speed and electric power in a real setting. Below are four working conditions of electricity generation in a real wind farm.

- The windmill blades start rotating when the wind speed reaches V1.
- The electric power output reaches a maximum (W) when the wind speed is V2.
- For safety reasons, the blades are prevented from rotating faster than they do when the wind speed is V2.
- The blades stop rotating when the wind speed reaches V3.

Which one of the following graphs best represents the relationship between wind speed and electric power output under these working conditions?

Alka now arranges a pile having 20 cans in the bottom row, ending with one can in the top row. The total number of cans in the arrangement are


