It was an exchange programme between German learners from Delhi and Pune. The students exchanged their ideas on the topic GESUND LEBEN (Good Habits For Being Healthy).

- Korean Cultural Centre India, Embassy of the Republic of Korea organised an #InternationalEssayContest 2020 on the topic "How will I Introduce South Korea to my Friends" (junior group) and "How South Korea Inspires Me" (senior group). The competition was open for the students across classes VI-XII. Sixty six students sent their entries. Ananya Garg, of Class XI got the III position comprising of a certificate and a cash prize of Rs 5000/-. Manya Arora, of Class XI got a special prize of Rs 2000/-.
- **Virtual Tour To TRAFFIC TRAINING PARK**_Under the ISA theme of Road Safety, a virtual tour was organised to Traffic Training Park on 20th August, 2020 for the children of class I. Children were explained about three modes of transport (land, water and air) and were also made aware of the basic safety rules.

- World Literacy Day- An E- assembly was presented by the students of classes I and II on 8th September, 2020. The students presented a vibrant song and dance show, made badges & bookmarks and recited rhymes.
- World Gratitude Day- Students of the Primary Department indulged in some interesting activities, such as making gratitude trees, gratitude jar and writing thank you letters.
- With the aim to empower the students, the Middle and the Secondary department has taken an initiative '**Traversing Territories**' to embed Research work as an effective pedagogical tool in its curriculum. This project intends to inculcate global awareness among students and to create global citizens who understand, respect and work well with people from diverse cultures and backgrounds.
- An assembly on the theme '**Virtual World**' was conducted by IX B on 29th October, 2020. The students presented ideas and facts in French, German, Sanskrit and Hindi. The virtual tours to Germany, France and India gave the assembly an international dimension.

- Our school is a part of ongoing International Flipgrid collaboration on 'Life in Covid times' with JS Morton High school, in Cicero, Illinois, US. Students of Classes XI and XII are part of it. Many students have shared videos which have been approved.
- International Day of Commemoration in Memory of the Victims of the Holocaust: Spreading Education and Awareness. Students of Classes IX and XI along with teachers attended the webinar organized by United Nations Outreach Programme on 29th January,2021 on the theme Facing the Aftermath: Recovery and Reconstitution after the Holocaust. Episodes from Anne Frank's diary were shown followed by a question-answer round.
- VIRTUAL EXCHANGE PROGRAM: Ten students and three teachers of the Pre-Primary Department interacted with the children and teachers of Beacon House Private School, Oman, through a virtual exchange program on 27th January, 2021. The students shared their traditions and culture with each other. On 3rd March, a special virtual assembly was organised between the two schools. The students from Oman were welcomed with a bouquet of flowers and greeted with 'Namaskar'. Our children chanted shlokas and displayed yoga poses. A short story based lesson on the topic 'Opposites' was also taken up along with an interesting thumb printing activity.
- World Food Day: Students of Classes I and II dressed up as chefs and participated in fireless cooking activity. They presented various recipes, wearing the traditional costumes of different States, and took a pledge to help create a hunger free world by not wasting food.
- World Peace Day and Gandhi Jayanti: Students from across all classes were acquainted with the ideologies of Mahatma Gandhi through various activities like Role Play, Art & Craft and Speech. A special assembly was organised wherein the students spread the message of spreading peace and living with compassion, kindness and love.

- World Diabetes Day: A Virtual Assembly presentation, by the students of VIII- C, on the theme World Diabetes Day was screened on 23rd November, 2020 to create awareness about the causes of the early onset of diabetes. It also focused on the necessary measures required to embrace a healthy lifestyle.
