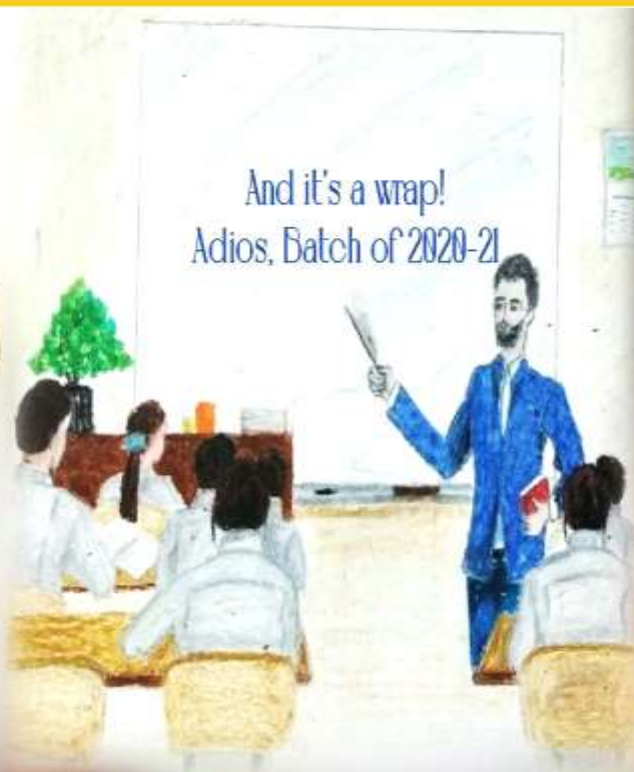

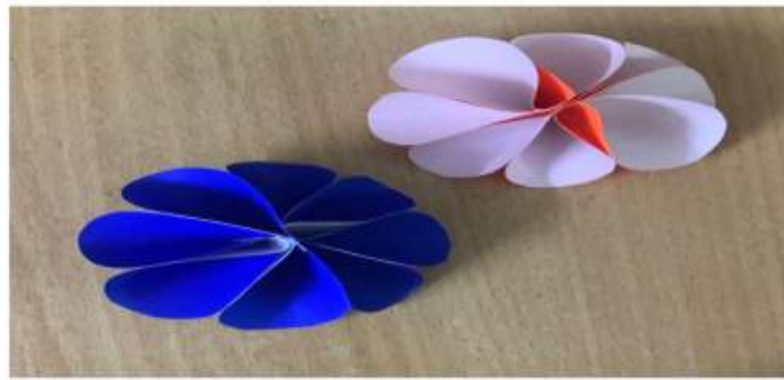

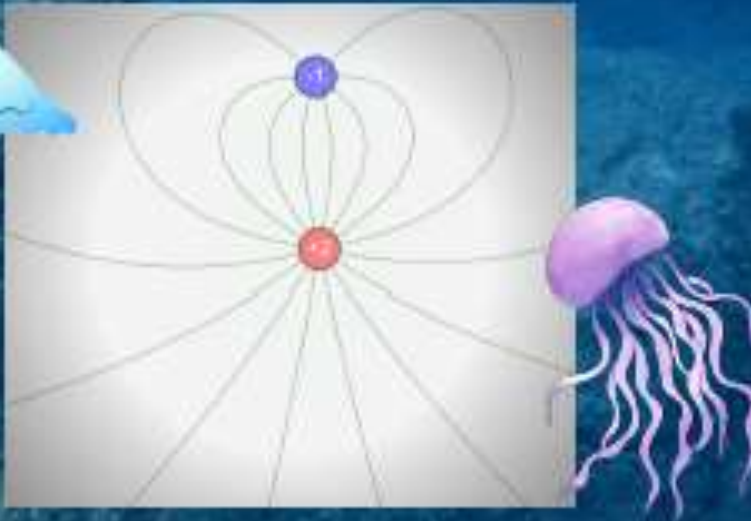

## SHOCKING FIELD OF JELLYFISH

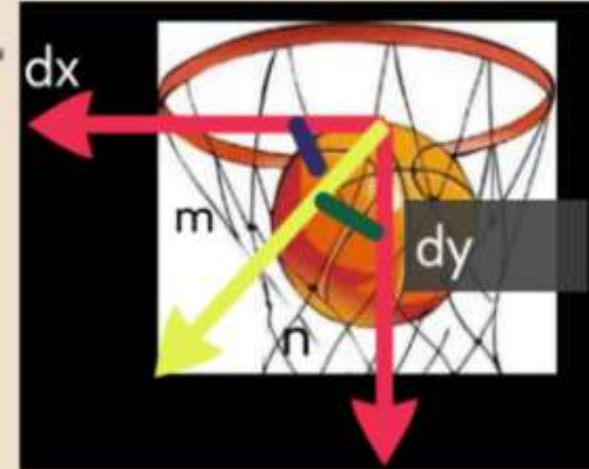
