- ❑ **Workshops on Impasto Technique (knife painting) are being conducted by the Art Department with the art club students.**



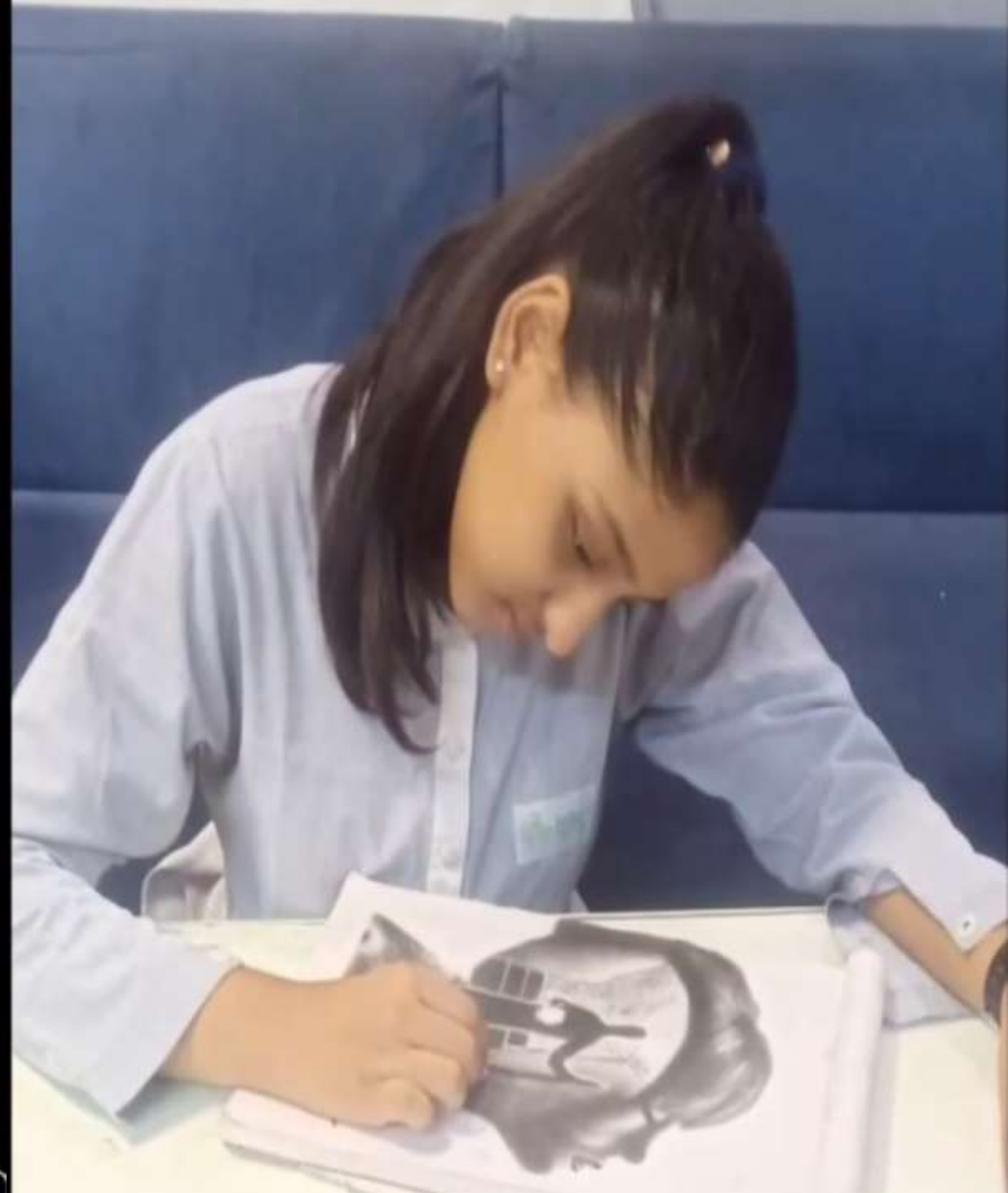

The school has also extended financial and emotional support to the families of children affected by covid.

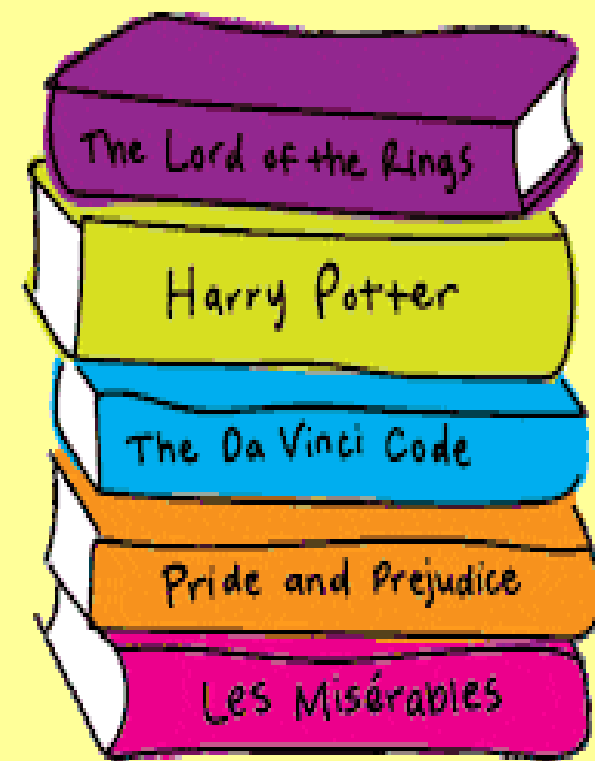

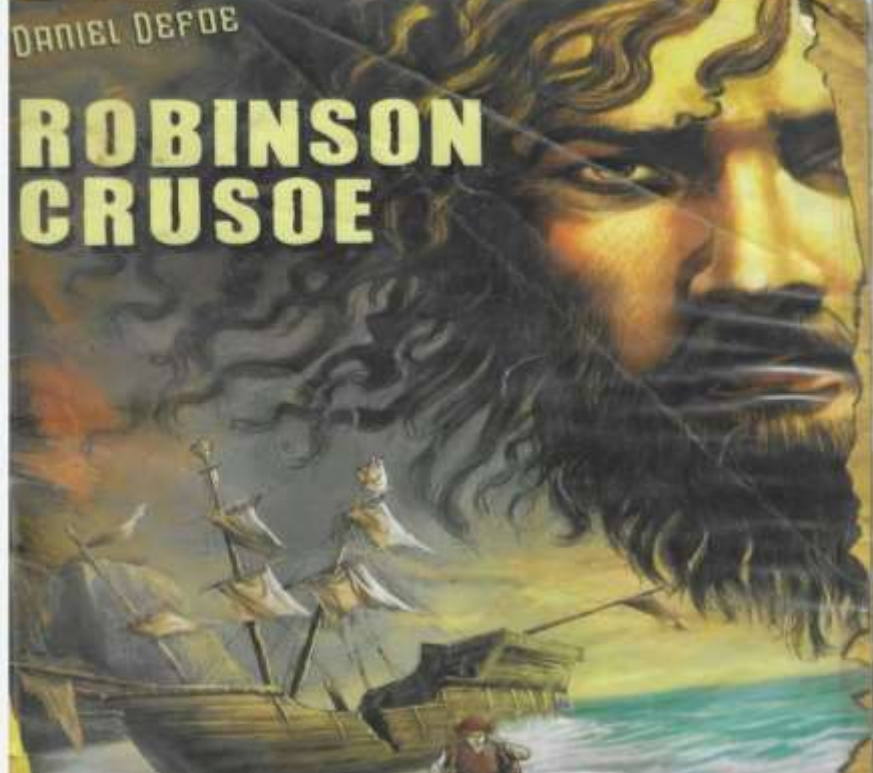

SAFETY AND SECURITY

The school opened for the students of Classes IX-XII in the month of September 2021. For the offline students all Covid related protocols were put in place. Classrooms were sanitized regularly, signages have been put up at all vantage points, Coaches are placed on duty to guide students for entry and exit of the school and during break time as well. For the students appearing offline every sanitization process and precautions has been maintained in the classrooms, Labs and in the corridor, in washrooms and in the drinking water area. The school is currently conducting Half Yearly Exams for classes X & XII in an offline and online mode in observance of all COVID related guidelines for offline candidates.





UPGRADATION IN TECHNOLOGY

Keeping up with the emerging technology trends can have a major impact on the way education is being imparted in schools today. It provides students with latest opportunities and unique learning experiences that they need and deserve. Treating this as priority, the school has taken the following measures:

24 classrooms have been upgraded and 45 more classrooms of Classes 6 to 10 are being upgraded with new Senses Interactive panels. They will be installed in the first week of November 2021.

UPGRADATION IN TECHNOLOGY

The school has upgraded old laptops with 40 new latest HP laptops. Notebook HP - 348 G7 - Intel Core I5 – 9400, 8 GB RAM / 256ssd/ 1 Tb HDD.

Portable interactive panel stands have been installed in the Senior and Primary libraries.

Offline and online training sessions of Senses Interactive Panels were conducted on Aug 23, 2021 and Sep 4, 2021 respectively.

We have installed a centralised Invertor cum UPS for school Local Area Networking (LAN).

The school is now completely a WiFi enabled zone.

Online Visitor Management System has been renewed from October 2021 onwards.

To provide OMR practice tests for students of classes 10 and 12, an OMR scanner and the required software have been procured by the school. The Computer and Examination Departments have been trained for the same.
