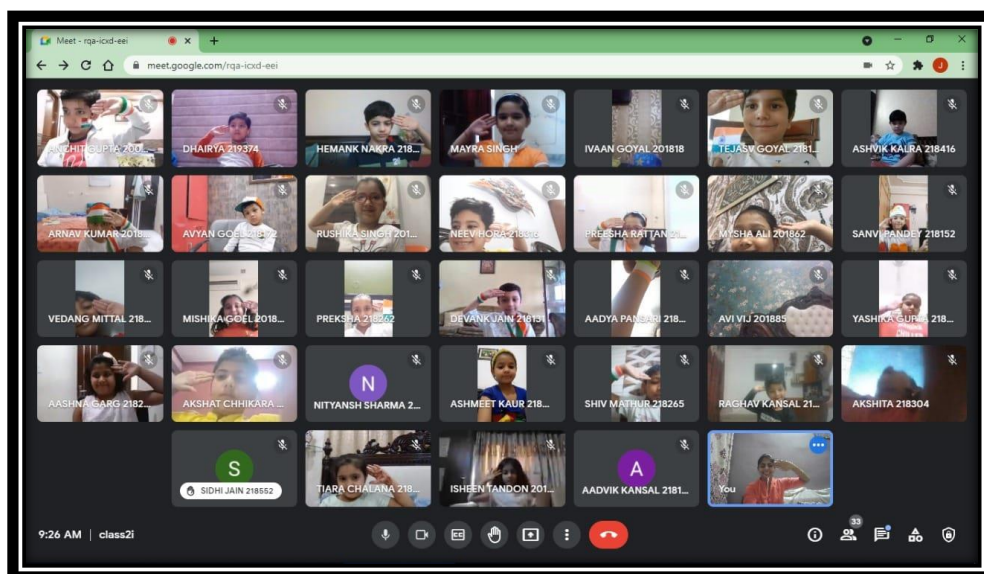
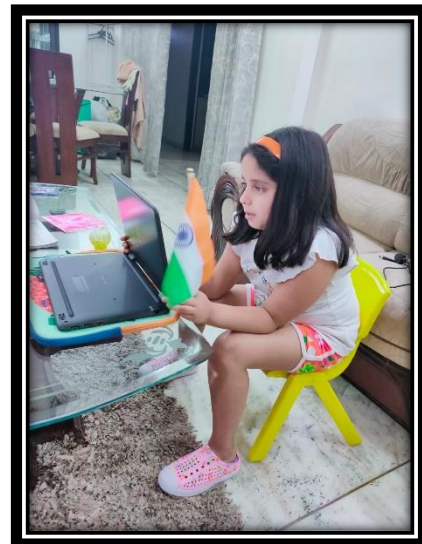
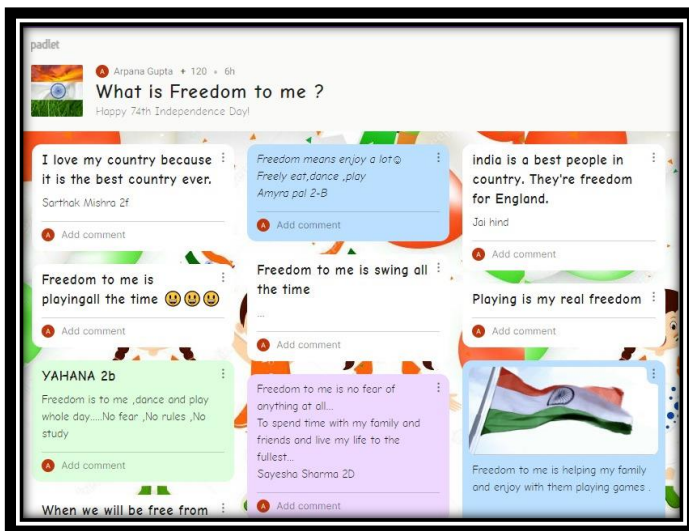


# AUGUST ACTIVITIES
