PROMOTION POLICY 2022-23

Promotion to the next class:

- i. Class III-V – No detention. Class to be repeated with the consent of the parent.
- ii. No retest in Classes III, IV & V for any kind of absenteeism. Only 'On Duty' cases and Class V (Term 3) absent cases will have a RE-TEST. Appearing in the RE- TEST for such cases is mandatory, else ABSENT will be marked.
- iii. Result for student absenteeism
 - a) Medical Cases: The child will be marked (AB), that is ABSENT but Subject Excellence Award will be considered provided the child should have appeared in two cycle tests for that subject.
 - b) Absent for any other reason: The child will be marked (AB), that is, ABSENT in the term result.
 - c) Class V: If a child misses 2 cycle tests of English, he/she will have to appear for the re-test.
- iv. Unit Test/Final Report Cards will be given to the parents or students with grades.
- v. Please discourage the child from missing an examination unless on ground of extreme emergency or illness.
- vi. **Attendance-** Every student must have a minimum of 75% attendance, failing which he/ she will not be promoted to the next class.
